Leasing opportunities here connect your brand to a dynamic, creative community with built-in foot traffic and frequent events in the heart of Orange County.

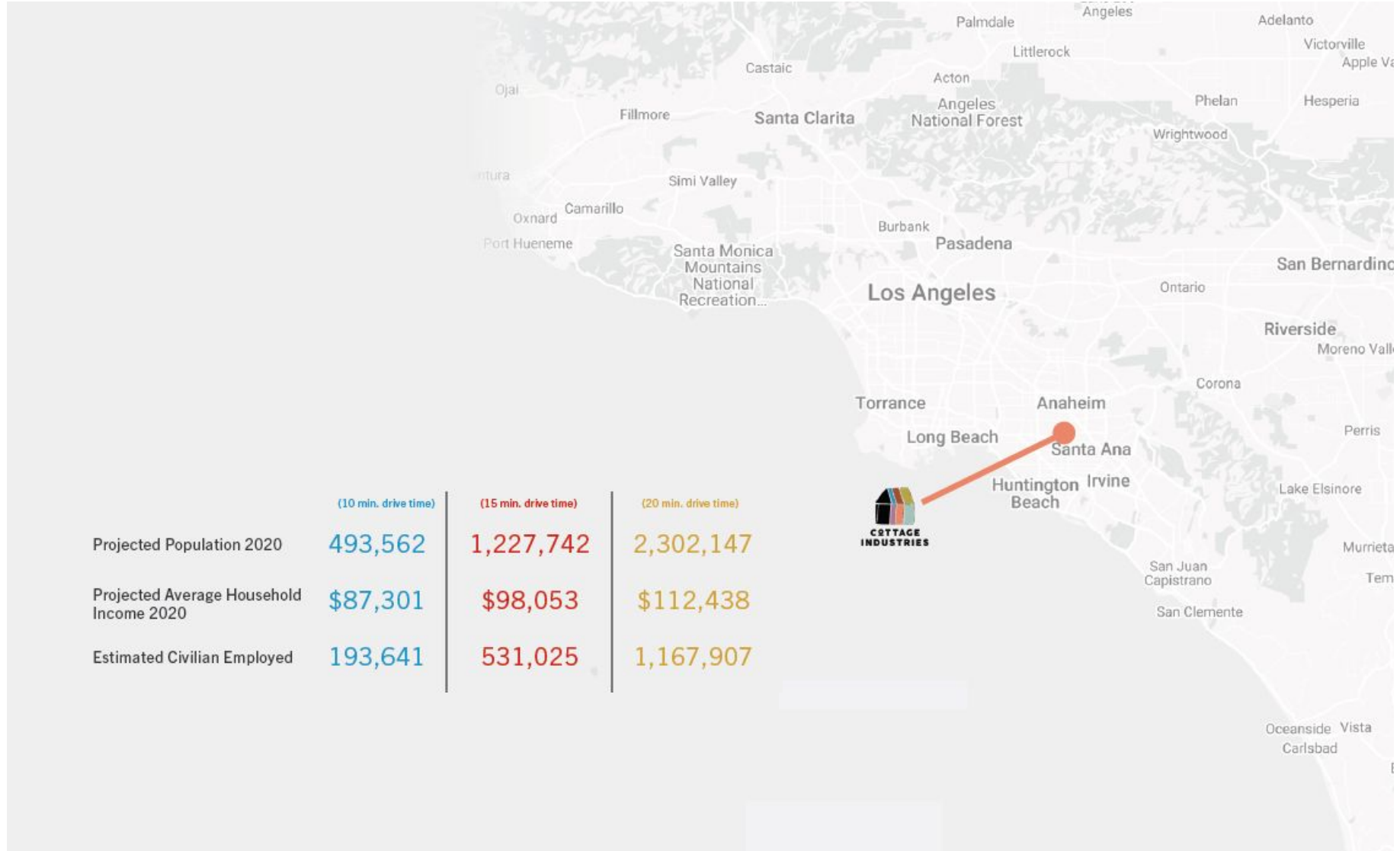

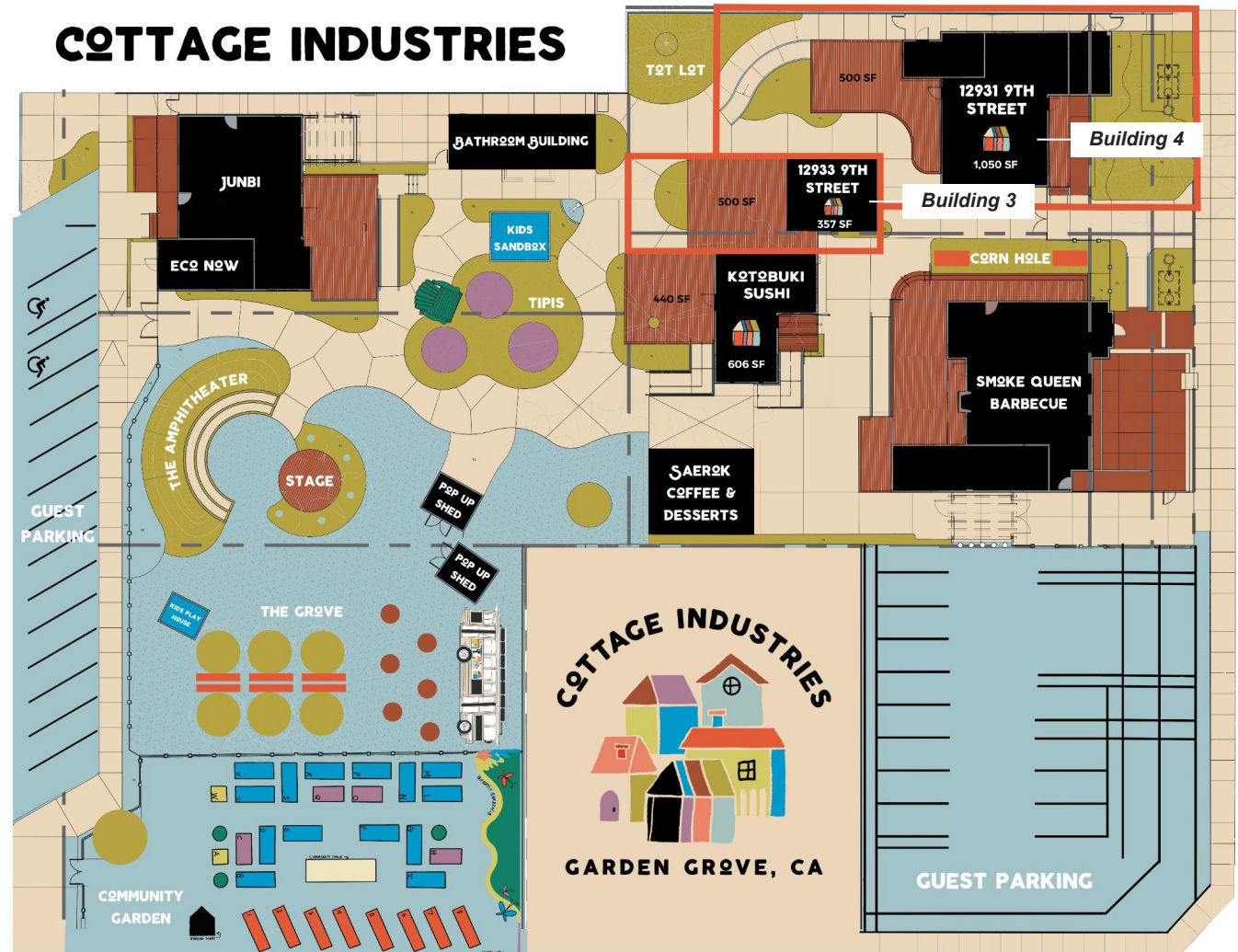
