


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LOCATION MAPS




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RETAILER MAP

Currently, 37.3% of the 71,282 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 48.3%, renter occupied; and 14.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 67,349 housing units in the area - 42.7% owner occupied, 46.9% renter occupied, and 10.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.55%. Median home value in the area is \$118,598, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.91% annually to \$124,069.
