

PROPERTY OVERVIEW

Suite #6240 is 1,094 SF, and is available right away. \$1,650/month (water/sewer & trash service included). 2nd floor space, has a kitchenette, 4 office/treatment rooms, and waiting room with reception. Shared bathroom in common area. The tenant is responsible for the electricity and internet. Preferred lease term 2+ years, but one-year would be considered.

Premier executive office park located on Aiken's south side. Three attractive, modern, multitenant buildings, totaling over 90,000 SF on 8 acres, provide tenants a variety of office spaces well suited for executive, administrative, medical, healthcare and corporate uses. Building 6000 was built in 1989 on fairly level topography, with asphalt paving (ample parking), concrete curbing & sidewalks, and good landscaping. The buildings foundations are on a concrete slab with a steel frame. Building exteriors are stucco with asphalt shingle roofs, and double-hung windows. The interiors boast atriums/common area on each floor, which includes: stairwells, elevator, restrooms, conference room (2nd floor) and kitchen (2nd floor). Recent Capital Improvements include: new roofs, resurfacing of the parking lots, and several new air conditioners have been replaced each year. Current tenants include categories such as: medical, counseling, financial, fitness, therapy, and engineering.

Located on the south side of Aiken's city limits, Woodside Executive Park is off of Silver Bluff Road less than two miles south of the Pine Log Road intersection, and surrounded by residential & commercial properties. 







































RETAILER MAP





LOCATION MAP


