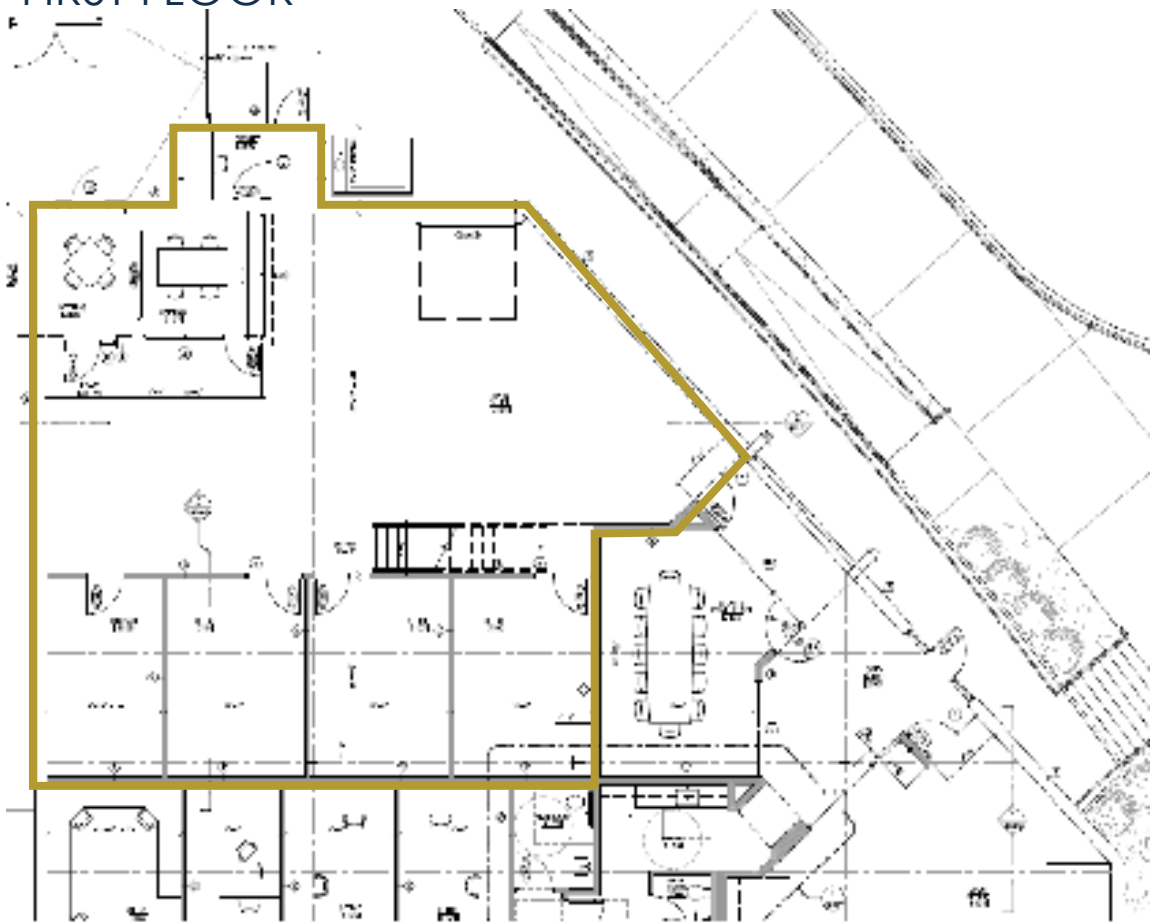

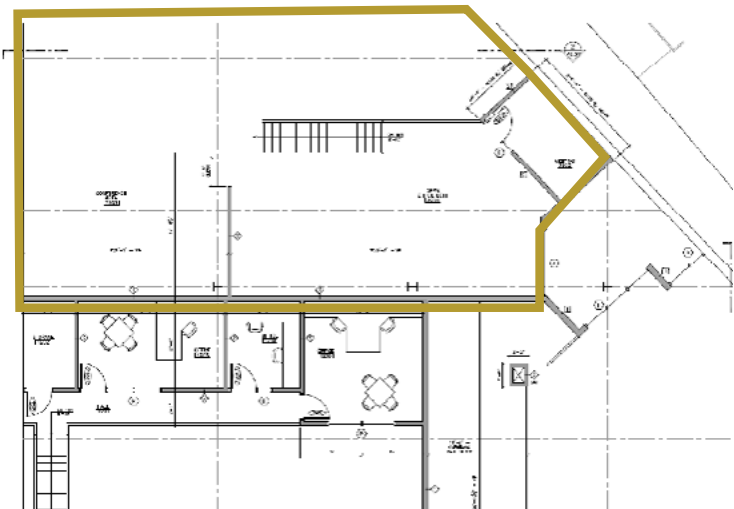


Floor Plan - Suite 140B

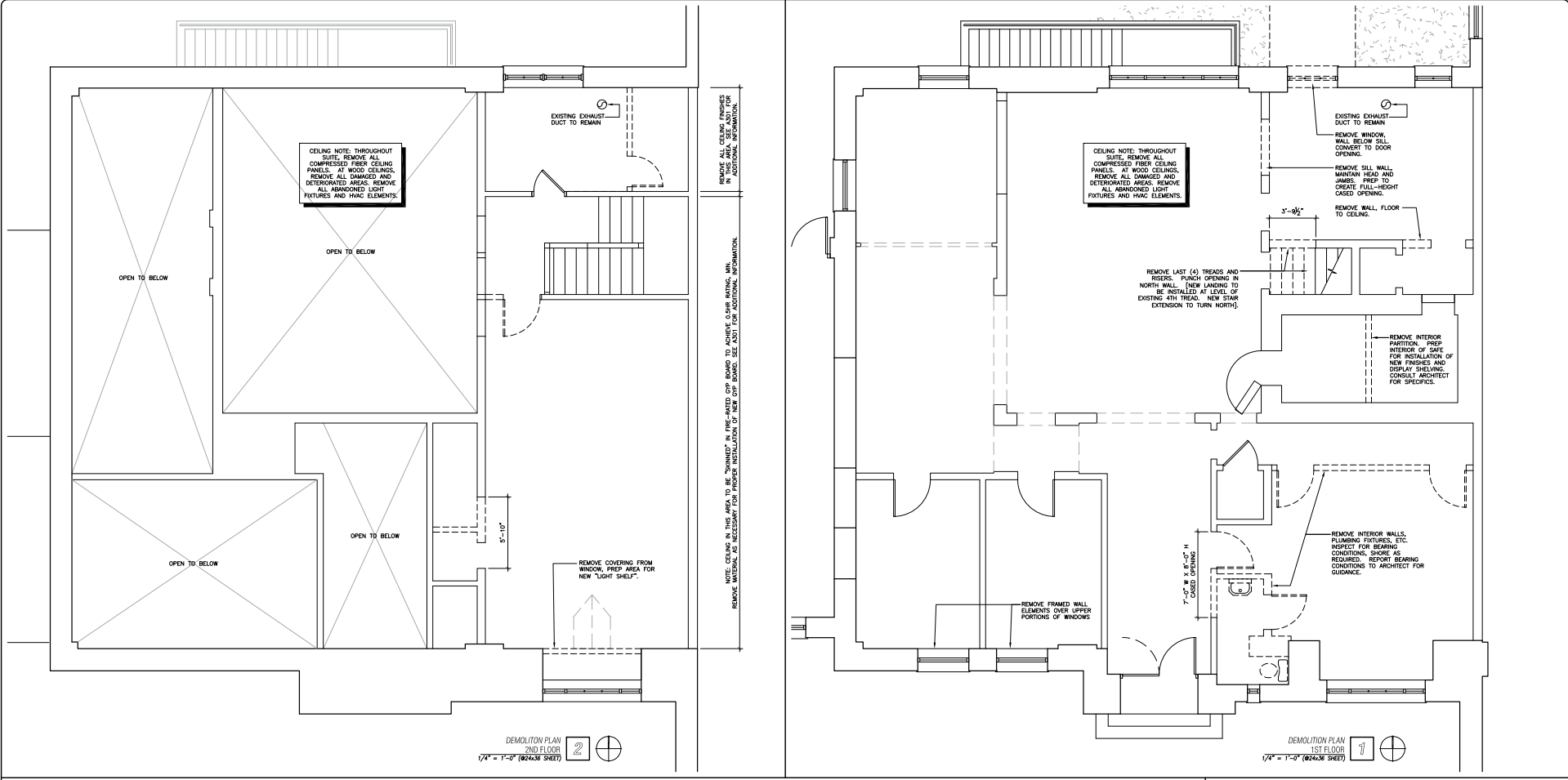

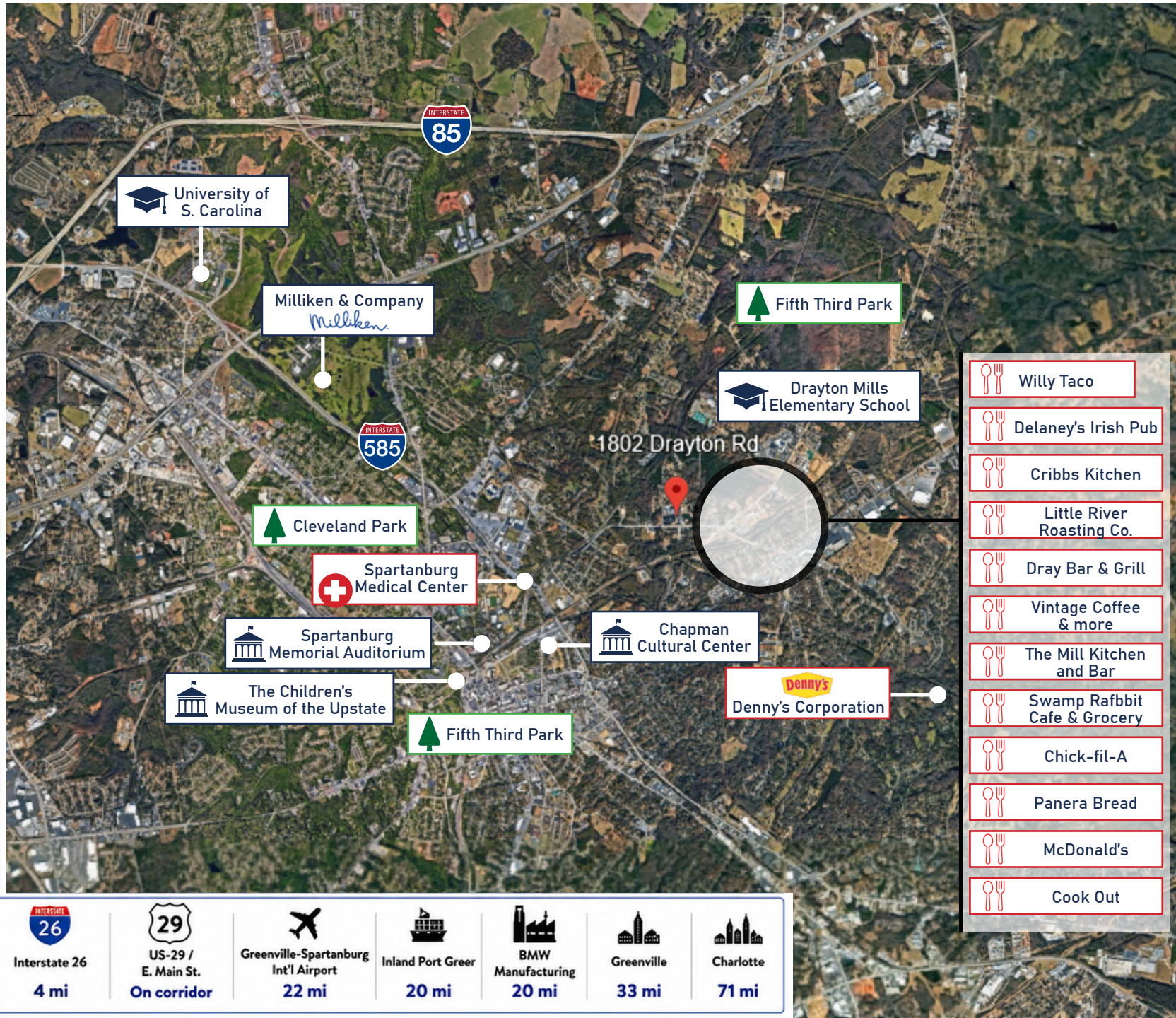

HISTORIC STATUS

Constructed 1902-1904, Drayton Mills has a rich history that has spanned over 100 years. The red brick-spinning mill was beautifully designed by the Boston engineering firm of Lockwood Greene & Co. and features Romanesque Revival and Tudor Revival architecture.

Over the years, additional structures have been added including a cotton warehouse, two water towers, a pond and office buildings. Architectural features with industrial charm are still present to the site including exposed beams, arched window bays, deep red brick and original hardwood floors.

Today the property is listed on the National Register of Historic Places which adds to the uniqueness of this master redevelopment. Operating as a textile and manufacturing mill beginning in 1904. At its peak, the mill employed approx. 1,200 workers and helped establish Spartanburg as one of the South's leading textile manufacturing centers.

Thriving Spartanburg

Spartanburg is one of the fastest-growing markets in the Southeast. The U.S. Census Bureau ranked the Spartanburg metro area the third-fastest-growing in the nation in 2025 by percentage, with the county's population increasing 2.8% in a single year to ~381K. Home to seven colleges and universities, the market offers a young, educated workforce and a deep, growing base of demand for retail, office, and residential space. Economic momentum is supported by substantial private investment. In 2025, Spartanburg County attracted \$3.5 billion in new capital investment and more than 1,000 jobs across 20 projects in advanced manufacturing, aerospace, and technology. The region's industrial base is anchored by BMW Manufacturing; the largest plant in BMW's global network and the leading U.S. automotive exporter by value at \$9 billion in 2025, along with Milliken, Michelin, Toray, Adidas, and Keurig Dr Pepper.

Located near the Central Business District, Converse College, Edward Via College of Osteopathic Medicine, University of South Carolina Upstate, Spartanburg Community College, Spartanburg Methodist College and Wofford College, this mixed-use development has become a well-known destination. Residents can walk to the surrounding community and enjoy proximity to events and the array of services offered by this unique combination of living, retail, office and restaurants at Drayton.

Award-Winning Community

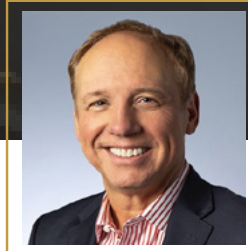
The South Carolina Department of Archives and History and Preservation South Carolina honored Drayton Mills with the Honor Award, one of the state's highest recognitions for historic preservation.
