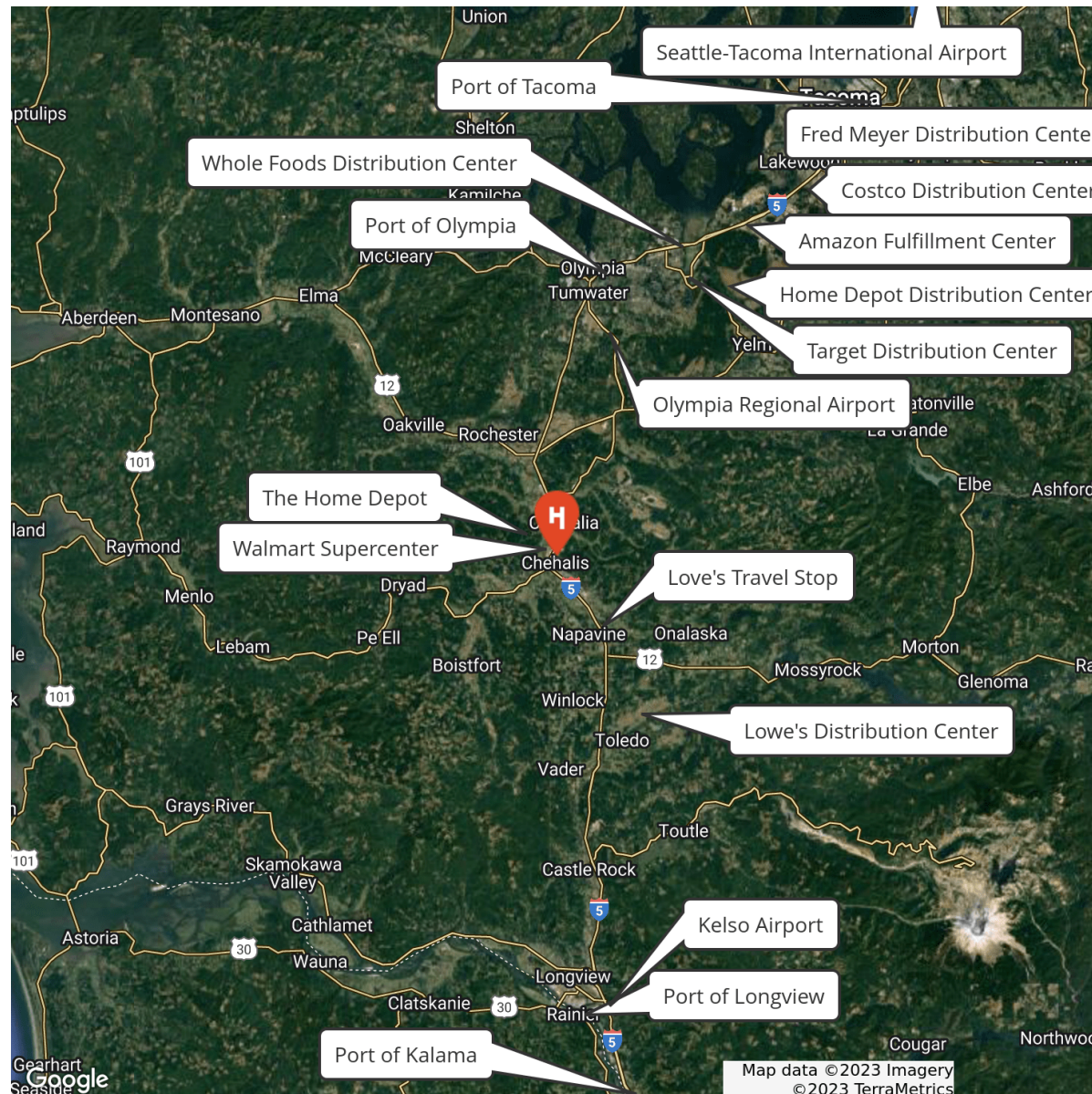


AREA OVERVIEW

Flood Map

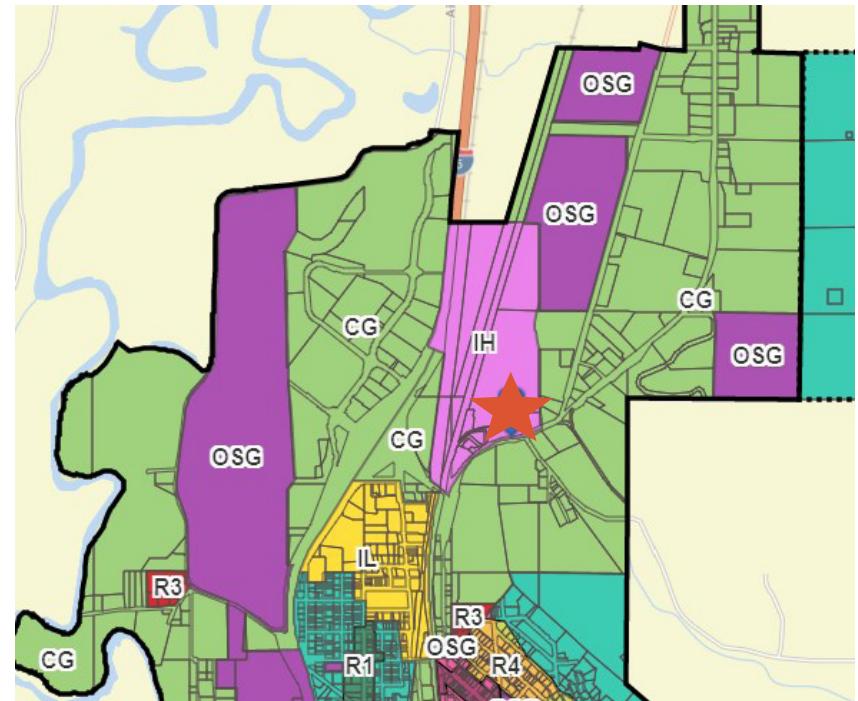
