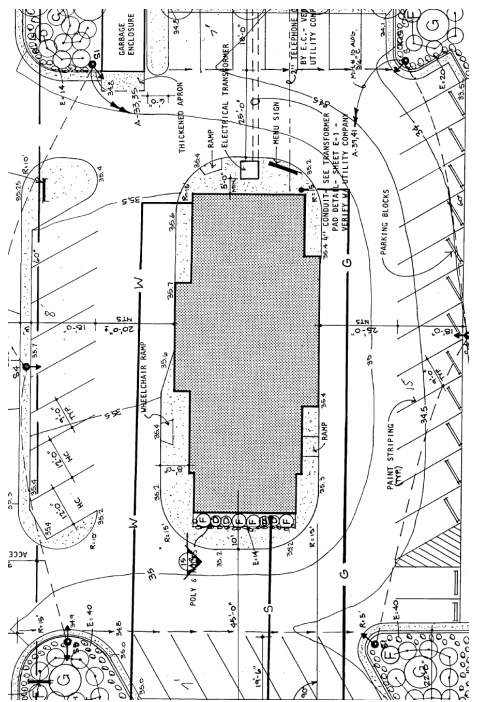

HEALTHCARE

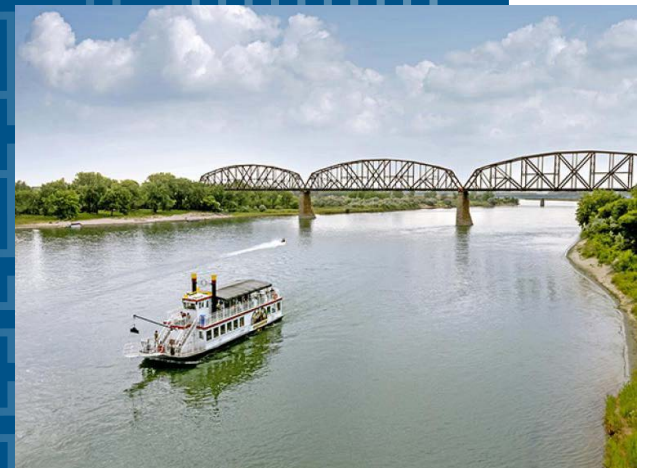
