



BOURBON SQUARE HISTORY

Bourbon Square has a rich 120-year history, evolving from a landmark hotel to a dynamic commercial hub along Colfax Avenue, the longest commercial corridor in the U.S. Originally constructed in 1905 as the West Vernon Hotel, the building was one of the first multi-story commercial properties on Colfax, shaping the district's transition from a residential area to a bustling business corridor. In 1948, it became home to a renowned saloon, attracting notable figures such as Elvis Presley and Clint Eastwood, the latter even filming a scene from *Every Which Way But Loose* outside the venue. Over the decades, the building underwent multiple transformations, including a rebranding as Syd King's Crazy Horse Saloon in the 1980s before ultimately being renamed Bourbon Square. The property continued to serve as a cultural and entertainment hotspot, housing the Irish Snug, one of Denver's most beloved pubs, until its closure in 2022. Today, Bourbon Square stands as a testament to Denver's evolving urban landscape, blending historic charm with modern potential for investment and redevelopment.
