Overview

Situated within a designated Opportunity Zone, this 9.01 acre development parcel presented by Avison Young offers prime positioning in Manor, Texas, part of the fast-growing Austin MSA. Located on E Howard Lane near Grand Central Drive, the property offers excellent access to SH-130, US-290, and I-35, and is surrounded by major employers.

Positioned between the Tech Ridge and Samsung Austin Semiconductor hubs, the site benefits from ongoing growth in advanced manufacturing, life sciences, and logistics. Nearby developments include Samsung's Taylor fab, the 425-acre EastVillage mixed-use project, and new multifamily communities along Parmer Lane.

This location supports future retail, mixed-use, or residential development, driven by strong infrastructure, employment growth, and rising demand.







