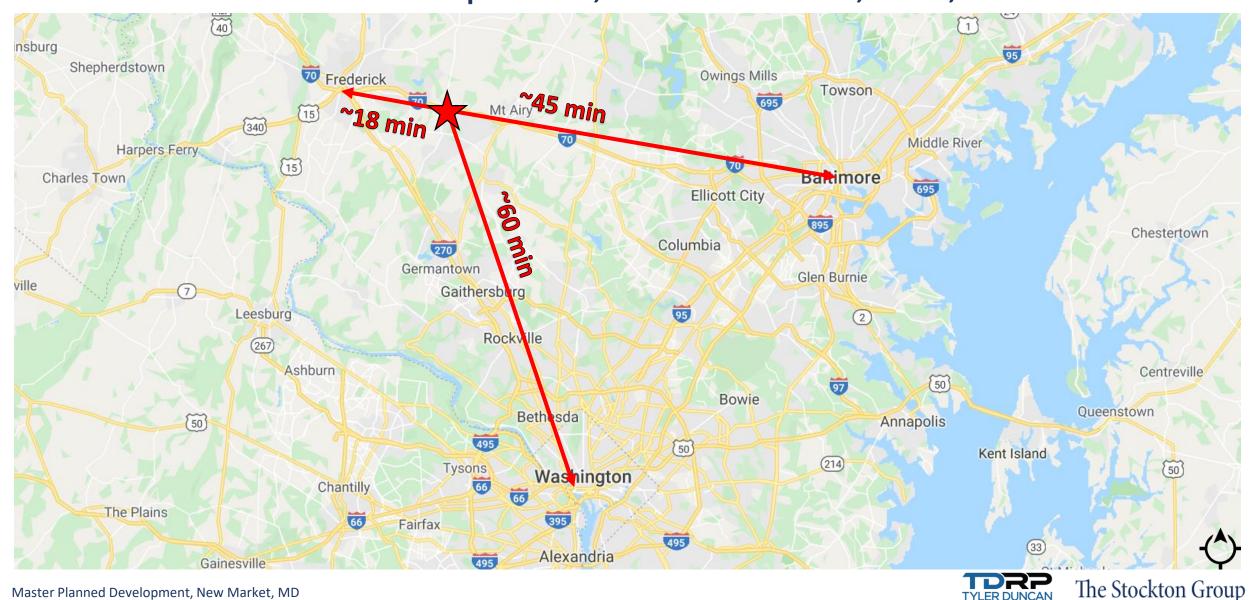
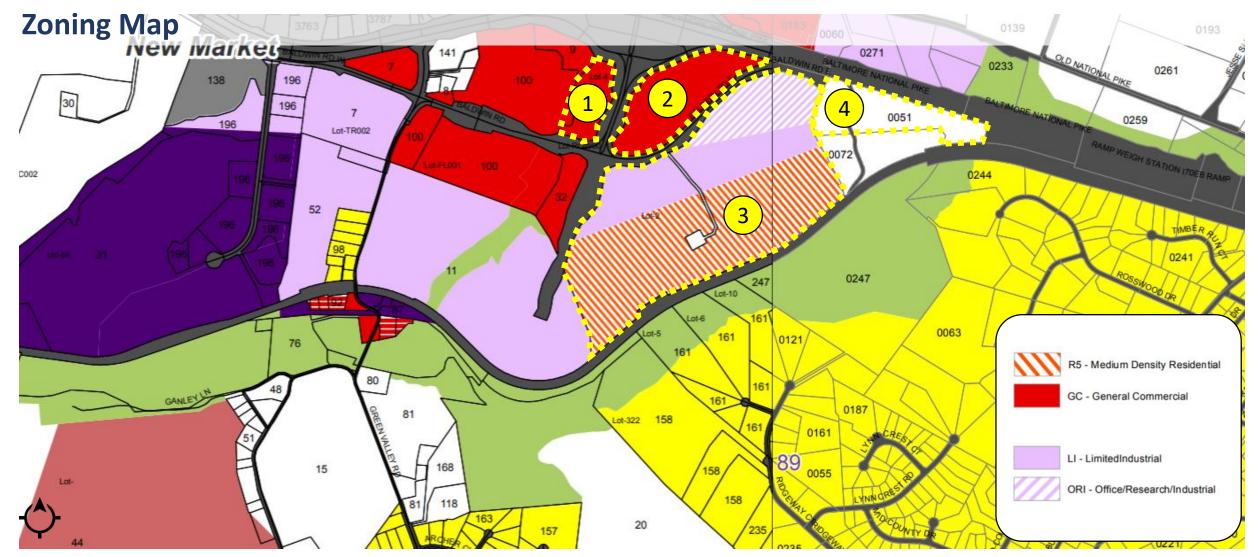

About Area
