After a decade of citywide struggle, Terminal Tower's exterior is illuminated top-tobottom to symbolize Cleveland's comeback. With the completion of the neighboring Key Tower, Terminal Tower becomes second tallest building in Cleveland and Ohio, which it remains to this day.


Historic Marvel to Modern Model


In the Heart of the Land


