The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has reviewed the release determination information dated February 26, 2024. Please note that if underground or aboveground storage tanks remain or are installed at this site, they continue to be subject to TCEQ tank registration, self-certification, financial assurance, and technical standards provisions.
