Qualtrics previously outgrew the subject property, leading to their acquisition of the adjacent former Morinda office campus.











Floor Plans




First Floor: 36,399 SF




Second Floor: 38,574 SF




Third Floor: 26,996 SF





Amenity Map




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- Forbes has ranked Utah as the Best State for Business 7 times since 2010

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
