The existing tenant, Green Oaks Dialysis Center is part of Innovative Renal Care (IRC), a comprehensive kidney care company with more than 230 dialysis clinics in 28 states, serving more than 16,000 patients. Their current lease runs through July 2028.

MISSION CRITICAL LOCATION

The property is adjacent to Arlington's primary business district along the Interstate 30 and Highway 360 corridors, home to a thriving business community and the HQ of American Airlines nearby. The property is also surrounded by a multitude of residential options and new residential developments, including the 2000 acre Viridian Community development. Its central DFW Metroplex location provides easy access to the major business centers of both Dallas and Fort Worth.

Located in the heart of the DFW Metroplex and home to University of Texas at Arlington, the fast growing City of Arlington has become a hotbed for young, well-educated talent.

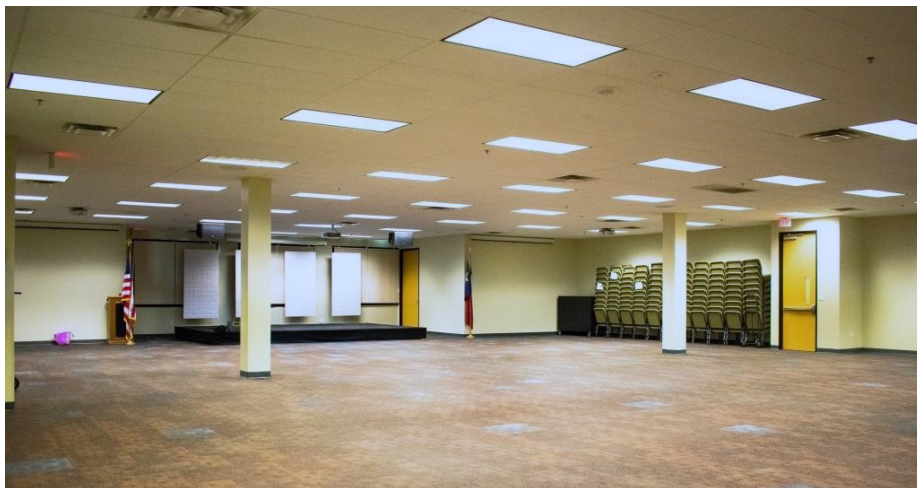
ENTERTAINMENT CAPITAL OF TEXAS

Site Information

- Lighted building identity sign at site entry with major tenant identity
- Three (3) plazas at entries with decorative paving
- Decorative entry walk
- 4.0/1,000 parking ratio (140 spaces, 26 covered)
- Fronts on Green Oaks and Brown Boulevards
- Heavily landscaped site with three site entry points

Ceiling

- Ceiling height 10'-0" (with 10'0" full height glass)

Windows

- Typical window mullions are 2" x 4 1/2" clear anodized aluminum, 8'-0" wide x 10'-0" high
- Vertical blinds - "Louver-Drape," perforated vinyl, 2 1/2" wide

Electrical

- Pad mounted transformer with meter
- 1000 amp, 480/277 volt electrical service, based on 15 watts per square foot of building area
- The main distribution panel has a 100 amp disconnect switch to serve common area loads (site lighting, exterior building lighting) with space for five (5) 200 amp fused disconnect switches to serve tenant loads

Exterior Building Finishes

- Steel frame with Austin stone veneer
- Dark gray 1/4" glass with aluminum mullions
- Twelve (12) foot high tenant entries with entry lighting

Entrance Doors

- Clear anodized aluminum with tempered glass

HVAC

- 20 Roof top units (Suite 100-13 RTUs/ Suite 190-7 RTUs)

Roof

- Joist girders, bar joist roof system and metal deck with 3-ply built-up roof on R-14 polyisocyanurate

Fire Safety

- Automatic fire sprinkler system
- Fire alarm system monitors sprinkler flow and tamper switches and has ADA/ TAS audio/visual devices

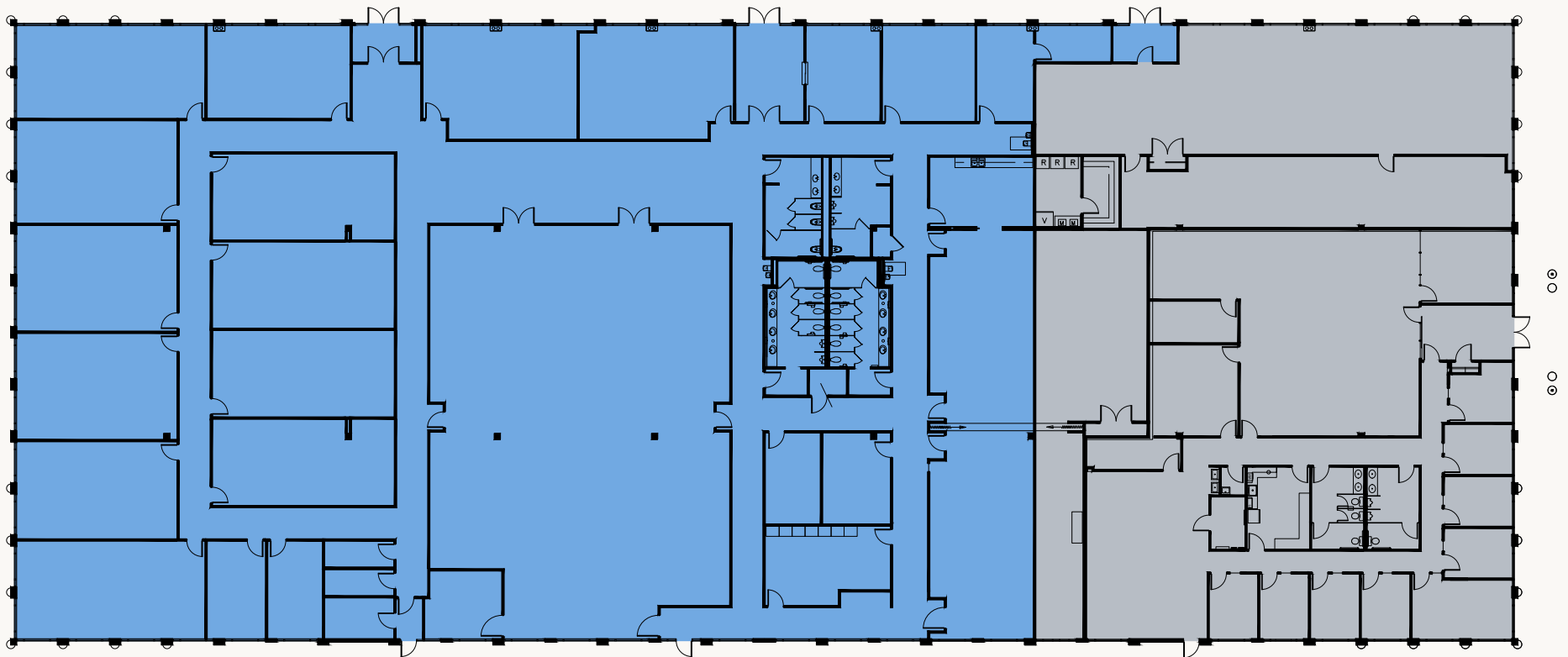
Exterior Lighting

Location Map



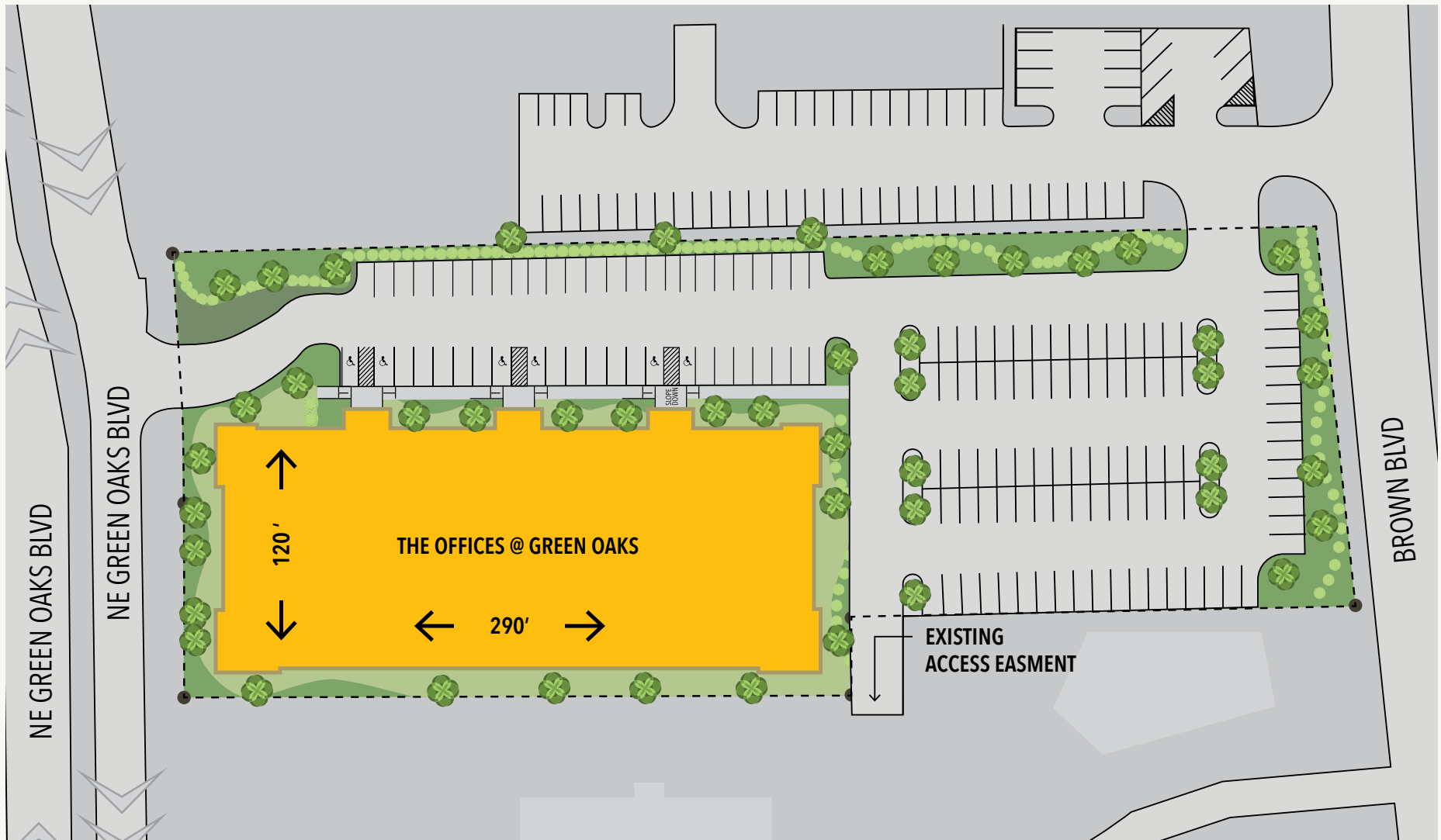
Floorplan
