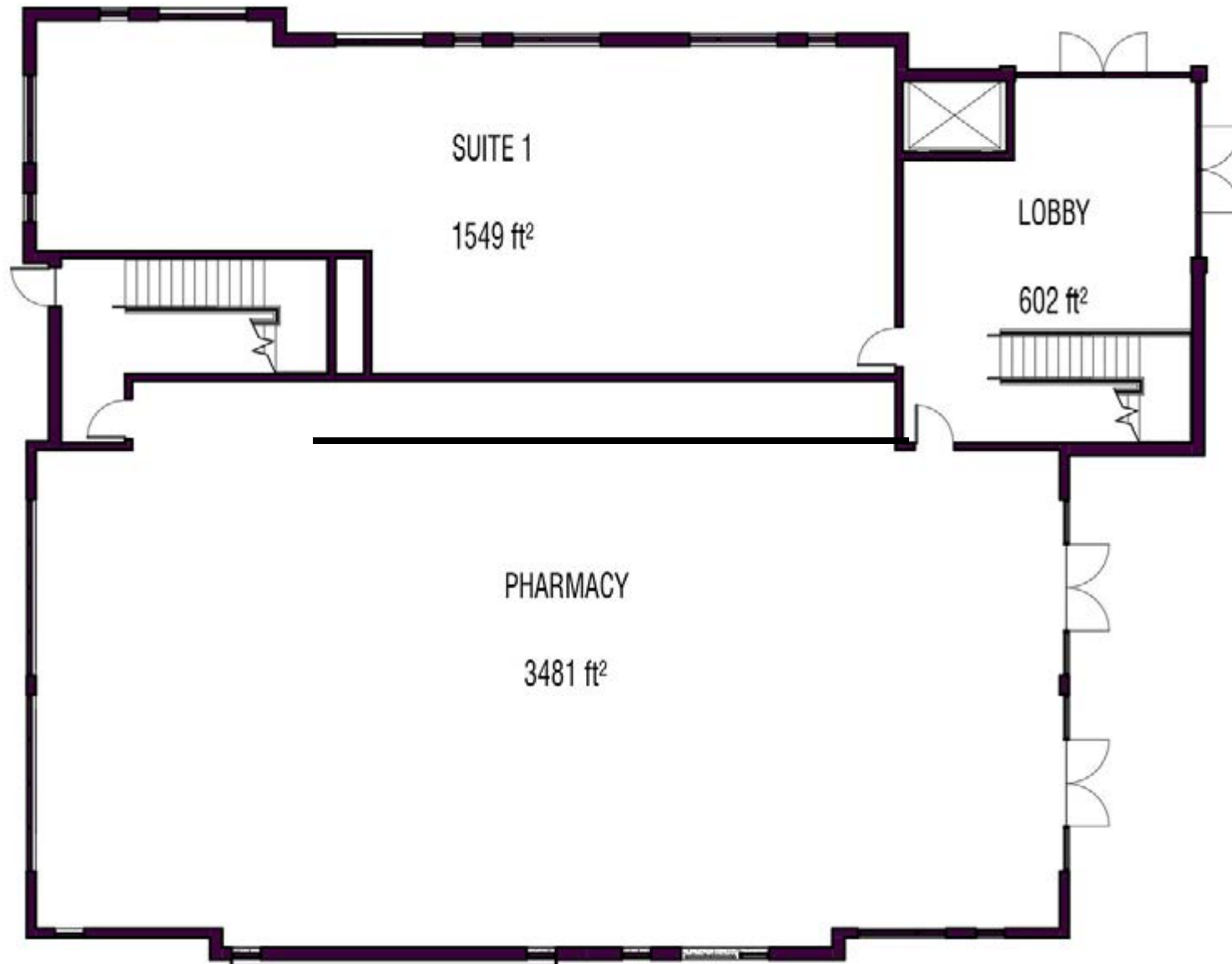

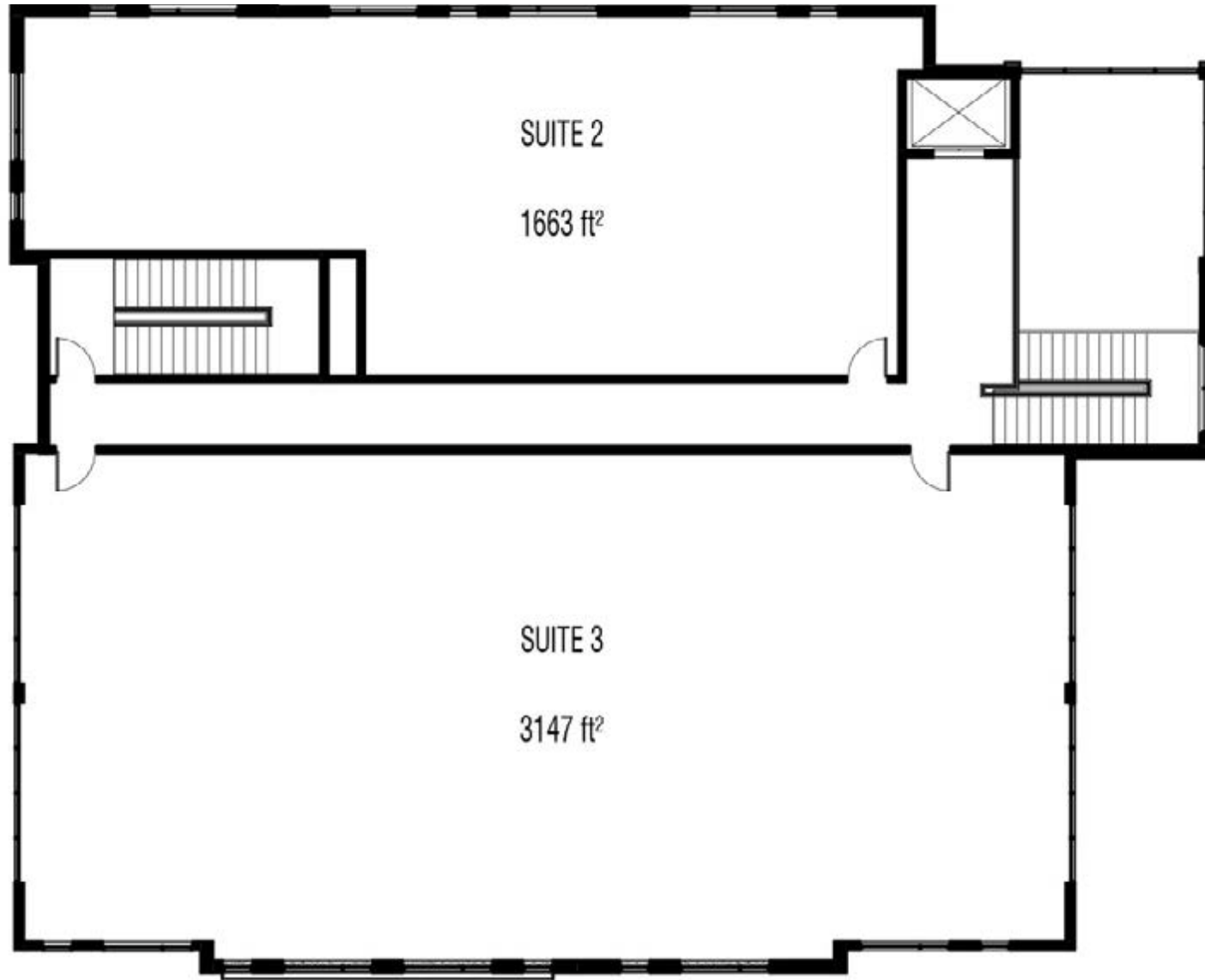

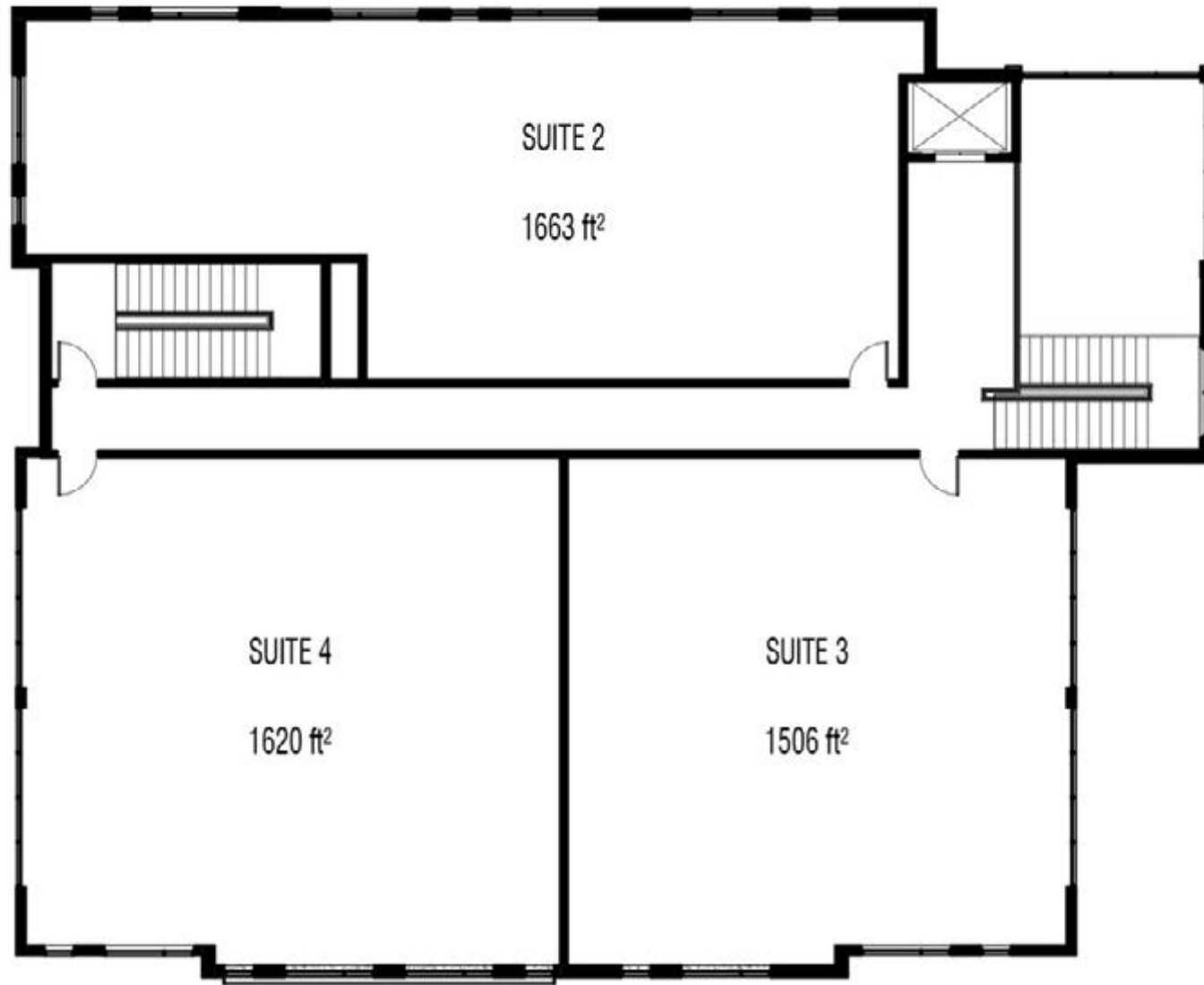
Floor 1

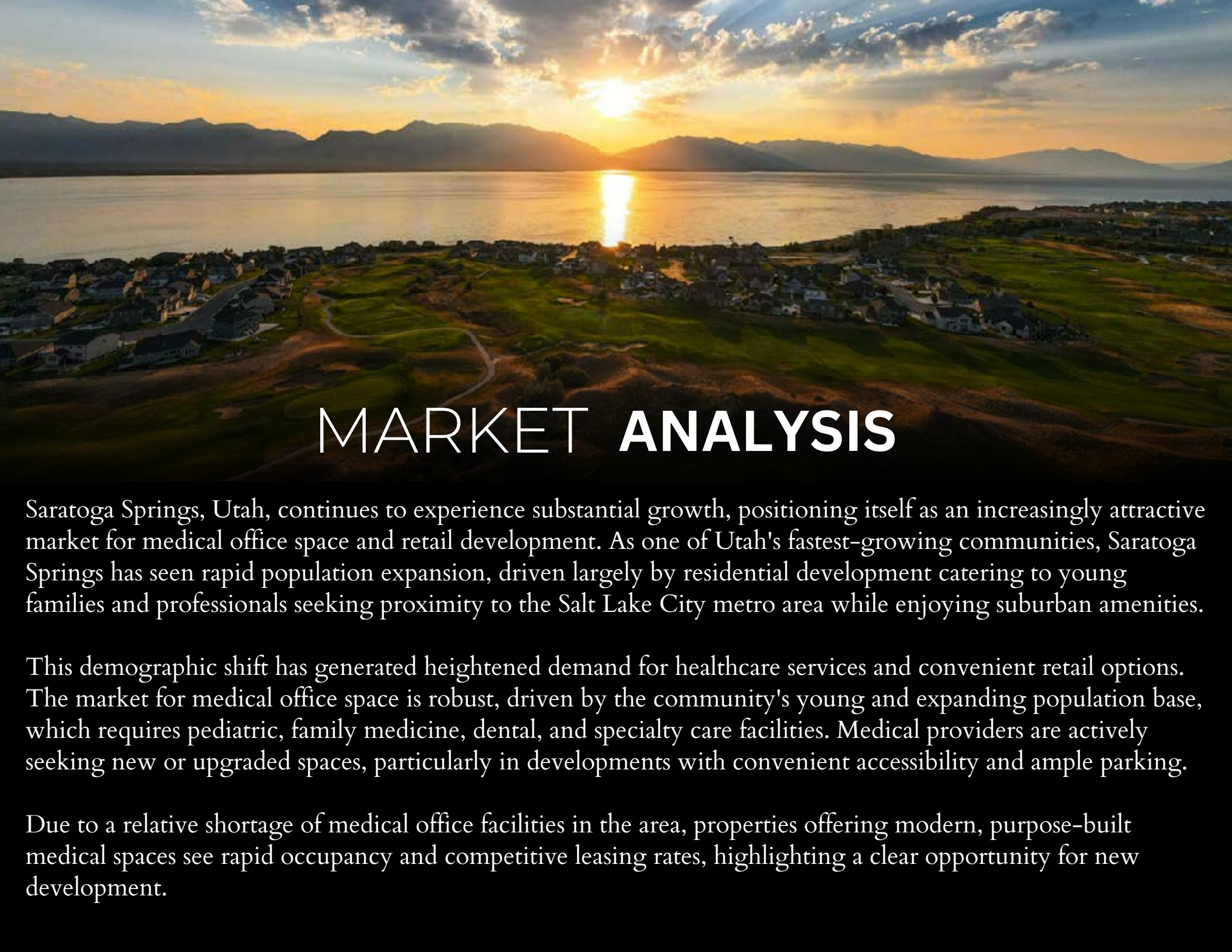
