PURPOSE OF THE BUILDING - Houses multiple courts: district courts, county courts, criminal courts, civil, and family law courts. - Contains key offices such as the County Clerk, District Clerk, District Attorney's Office, Records Management, and the Law Library. - Used for hearings and proceedings under the jurisdiction of Denton County. DETAILS AND NOTES - Public Hours: Monday–Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. - Built in 1997, it is a modern courthouse facility for Denton County. - Visitor Information: Parking and department listings are available on the county's official website.
