



FACTS ABOUT LITITZ

- Lititz is located in Lancaster County, approximately 8 miles north of the city of Lancaster.
- Lititz Borough has a population of 9,385 people, and occupies a total area of 2.3 square miles.
- PA Routes 772 (Main St.) and 501 (Broad St.) are the major East-West and North-South streets in the town.
- In 2013 Lititz was voted America's Coolest Small Town by Budget Travel.
- Home to Linden Hall, the oldest independent boarding and day school for girls in the country.
- Local attractions include the Wilbur Chocolate Store, the Julius Sturgis Pretzel Bakery, Lititz Springs Park, and the Thursday's Farmers Market where fresh produce, baked goods, and entertainment are available each Thursday evening mid-May through mid-October.
- Lititz hosts many well-attended annual events which include the Lititz Fire and Ice Festival, the Lititz Chocolate Walk, the Rotary Craft Show, the Lititz Craft Beer Fest and Second Friday an evening of food, festivities and music held on the second Friday of every month.

MISSION & VISION STATEMENT

Their faith-based mission provides opportunities and services that enrich the journey of aging: Moravian Manor is a not-for-profit senior living community offering a person-centered approach to a full continuum of services. Their vision is to be a unique community within a community that excels at anticipating and accommodating the changing lifestyles, expectations, and needs of the people we serve.

HISTORY

Established in 1975, Moravian Manor's history is rooted in the early works of the Moravian Church in Pennsylvania. The foundation for Moravian Manor was established in the 1950s through the early works of the Moravian Church to care for its aging members. In the early 1970s, the Lititz Moravian Church donated 22 acres in town to construct the retirement community. The Manor welcomed its first residents to the Moravian Avenue Cottages in late 1974 and to Manor West Personal Care (formerly called the residential wing) in January 1975. From 1975-1979 additional cottages were built along Moravian Ave. 1983-1984 the Manor Greene apartments were constructed. In 1986 a new personal care wing was opened. In 2000, Moravian Manor celebrated its 25th anniversary. A major expansion and renovation project to add new independent living apartments, enhance facilities for the west wing assisted living center and renovate the Health Center was launched. The new Garden Court apartments were finished in 2003. In 2009 the Manor East Health Center's two story expansion and renovation project – the South Wing, which provided for more private rooms and a more home-like atmosphere, was completed. During this year, they also initiated a change in philosophy, with regards to our approach to health care, to adopt a hospitality model that focuses on resident-centered care. The Health Center renovations to create three smaller neighborhoods, each with a dedicated care base, were finished in 2011. A new recreation area-complete with a three-hole putting green, bocce court and shuffleboard court was constructed in 2012. And in 2014, after a year of planning and concepting, the new Warwick Woodlands project, to be set on 72-acres of a former landscape nursery, started its pre-sales phase. Phase I of this new neighborhood that includes: townhomes, carriage homes, and apartments, broke ground in 2016.

Looking to the future, they remain dedicated to the continual improvement of accommodations and services that they offer to their residents and the local community.
