NEW CONSTRUCTION TOWNHOMES, RESTAURANTS AND SHOPPING

JAMES RUN

 **5.6 miles / 13 min.**

Harford County's newest mixed-use project. Set to deliver in Spring of 2022, the project will feature 6 apartment buildings (300 units), townhouse villas (191 units), townhouse apartments (79 units) and an assisted living facility (100 rooms). James Run will include retail (inline, end cap, drive-thru, various sizes), freestanding restaurants (proposed 7,000 square feet each), office/medical space (proposed 14,000-30,000 square feet ea., 1 & 2 stories) and a hotel (proposed 5-story, 125 rooms).



MARYLAND GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB

 **4.1 miles / 8 min.**

This private, full-service country club in Bel Air, MD, offers a variety of meeting/seminar rooms, dining rooms and banquet space to accommodate up to 300 guests. Many weddings and receptions are celebrated here, in addition to the many members and guests that come for its golf course and tennis courts.



HARFORD COMMUNITY COLLEGE

 **.5 miles / 2 min.**

Founded in 1957, Harford Community College now occupies 332 acres and comprises 21 buildings, totaling over 287,000 square feet, and is home to 20,000+ students and an academic staff of 106.



ABERDEEN PROVING GROUND

 **15.3 miles / 31 min.**

Aberdeen Proving Ground employs more than 7,500 civilians and 5,000 military personnel. It is Harford County's largest employer and also one of the state's largest employers. APG is also home to the U.S. Army Ordnance Museum.



HAVRE DE GRACE, MD

 **11.7 miles / 18 min.**

Situated at the mouth of the Susquehanna River and the head of the Chesapeake Bay, Havre de Grace was named one of America's 20 best small towns to visit by *Smithsonian* magazine. The area is popular for its recreation and tourism, with a restored promenade and boardwalk that run along its shore from the Concord Point Lighthouse to the yacht basin, and also boasts numerous museums.



BEL AIR, MD

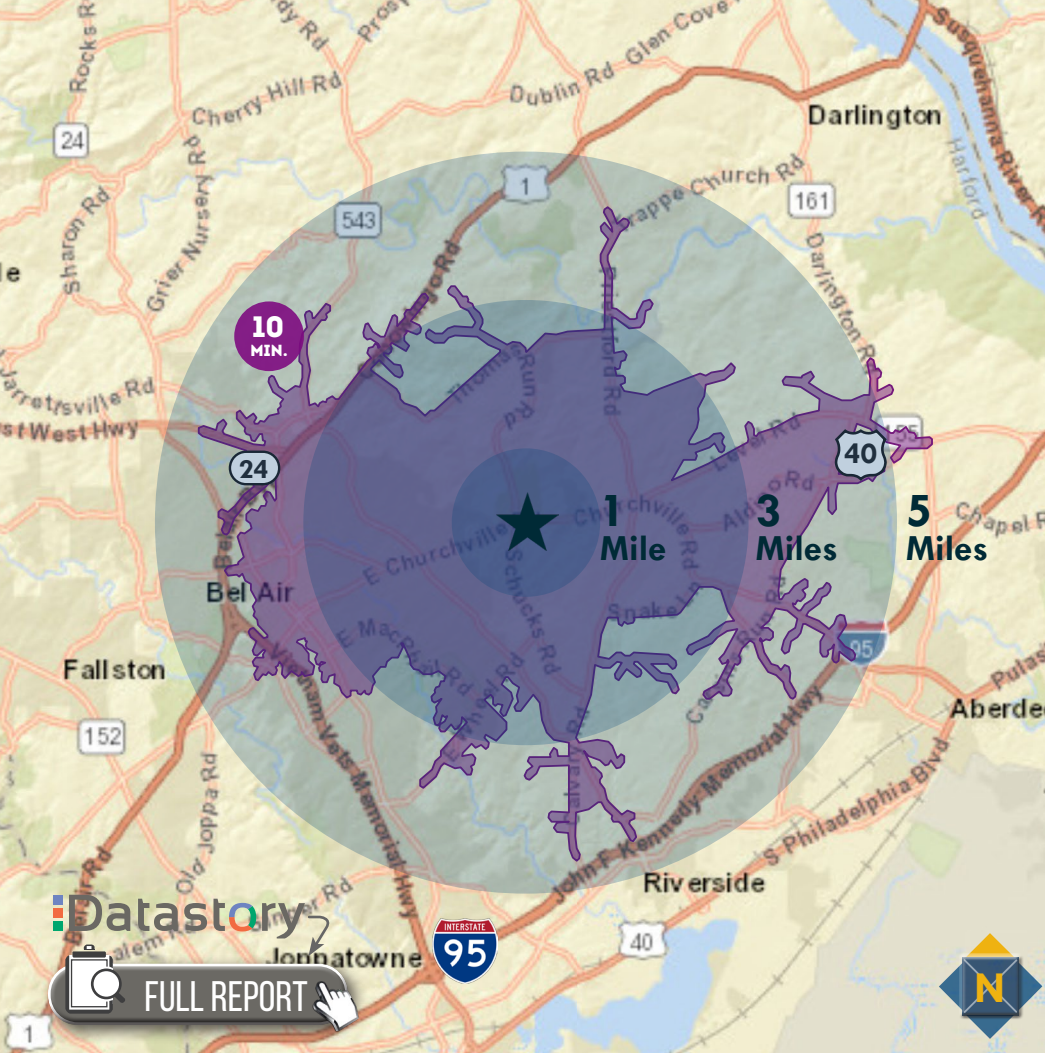
 **4 miles / 11 min.**
