

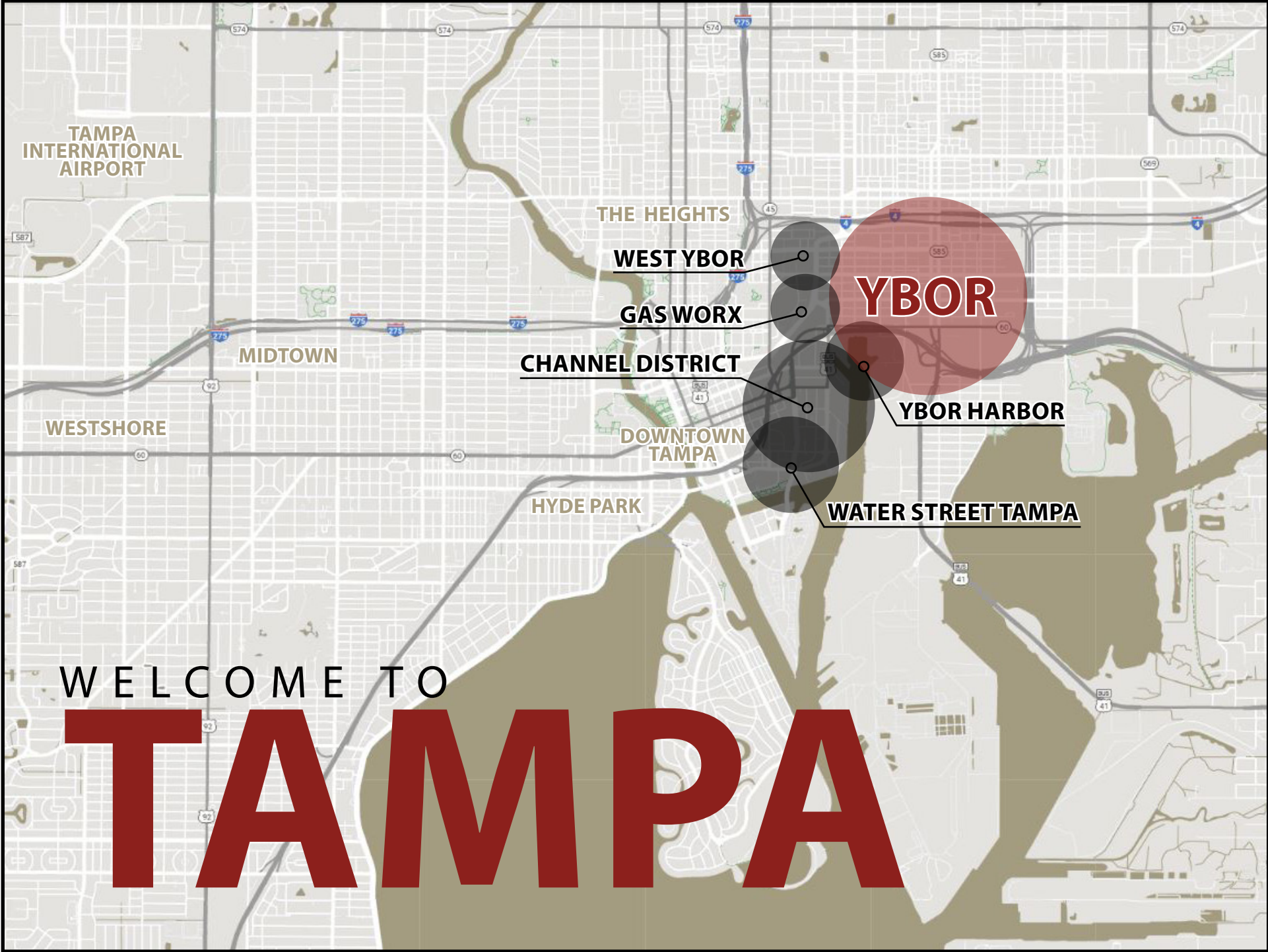

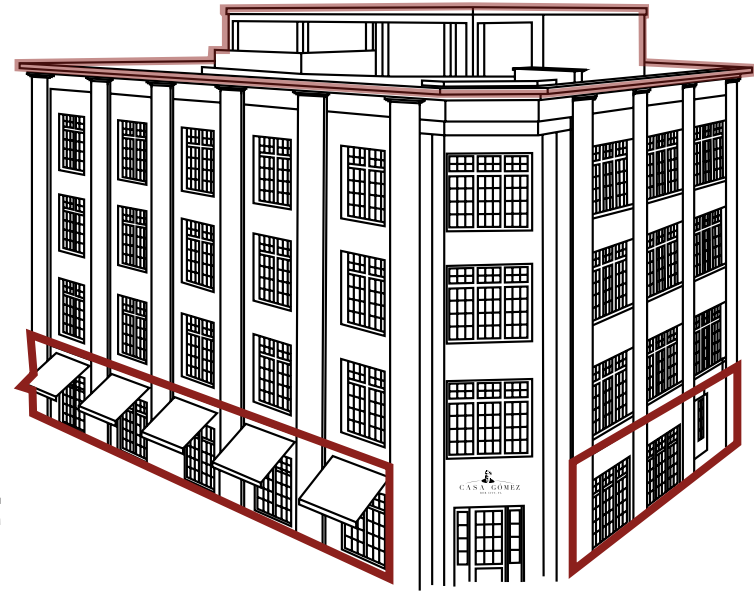

“THE CIGAR CAPITAL OF THE WORLD”

- 1886 - First **Cuban Cigar** makers came to the Ybor City
- The port, railroad, and the climate for the tobacco leaf were main drivers
- At its peak, **Ybor City had 150 cigar factories producing 500 million units annually**

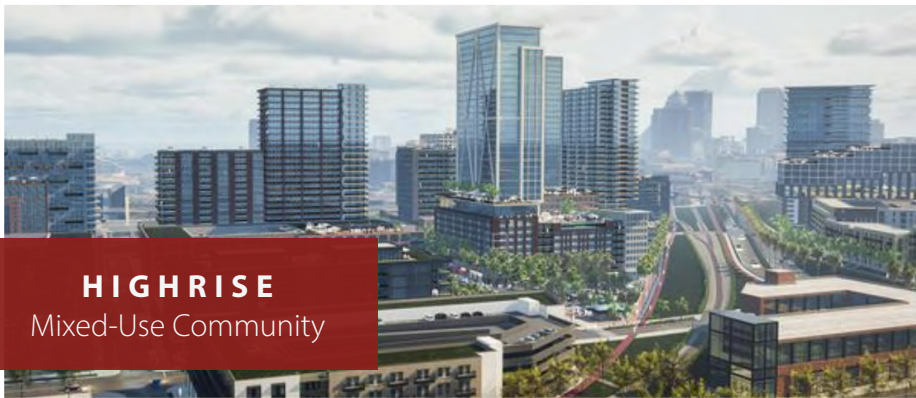

Below is a proposed aerial view of the proposed Gas Worx project. A residential complex would replace the Tampa Park Apartments just west of Nick Nuccio Parkway. A park would replace a roundabout near Channelside Drive and Fourth Avenue. More residential towers would line the southern boundary near Adamo Drive.

Florida Ranks #1 in Total Net Migration

Florida also ranked #1 in domestic migration, #2 in international migration, and #1 with the most people moving in per day at 1,218. Texas followed Florida in both total net migration (349,575) and most people moving in per day (958). Florida's total population has reached more than 22.2 million and sits third in the nation behind California and Texas, previously surpassing New York.
