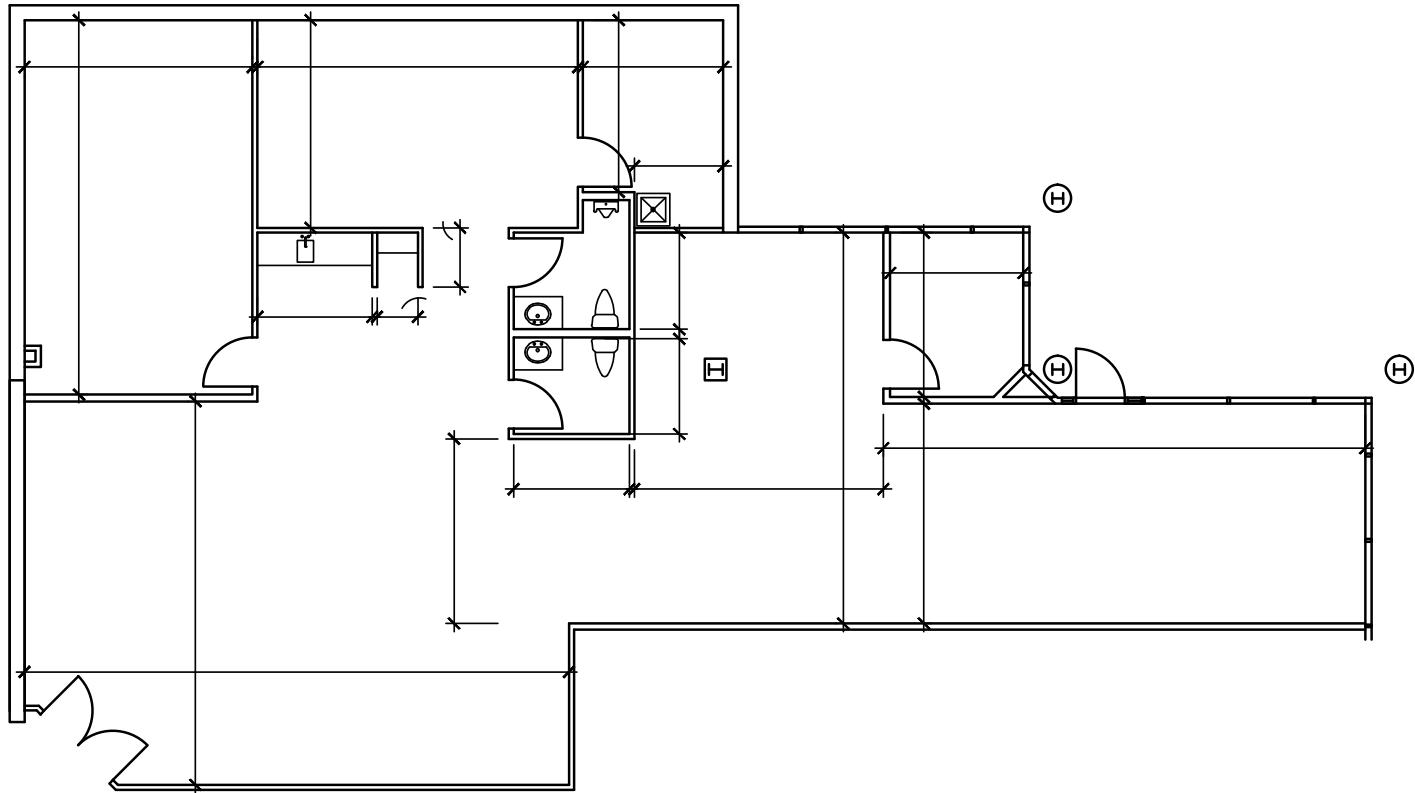

Dublin has organized a cross functional team called Review Services for commercial plan reviews. The team is comprised of specialists from Standards, Planning, Engineering, and the Washington Township Fire
