

Austin market overview


Austin is the fastest-growing metro in the nation with approximately 2.3 million residents. Known for its vibrant culture, live music, and renowned universities, Austin has seen its GDP nearly double since 2010, with a 36% population growth. The city's economy is strong, driven by industries like advanced manufacturing, clean technology, and tech, with 17% of jobs in the tech sector. In 2022, venture capital investments in Austin totaled \$4.9 billion.


The region boasts a robust higher-education system with over 160,000 students, ensuring a skilled workforce. Major universities include the University of Texas at Austin and Texas State University. Over 90% of residents are high school graduates, and nearly 47% hold a bachelor's or advanced degree.
