- Approximately 2,884 feet of frontage/visibility along I-40 with an additional 698+ feet frontage along the I-40 West Bound on ramp and approximately 809' frontage along Hawkins Crawford Road.

- 2022 Population of 78,082, Household Income \$72,452 within a 10-mile trade area with over \$1.6+ billion in annual consumer expenditures.



The City of Cookeville, located in Putnam County, TN was incorporated in 1903, is located 79 miles east of Nashville and 101 miles west of Knoxville at the intersection of I-40 and Highway 111 in the Upper Cumberland Region of Middle Tennessee. The Municipality's land area is 35.89 square miles. Cookeville is the county seat of Putnam County and is the largest of four cities located within the county.

Cookeville offers a wide variety of small shops, boutiques, restaurants, recreational opportunities, and much more.

Cookeville is home to Tennessee Technological University (TTU) and Cookeville Regional Medical Center (CRMC) and is one of the fastest growing micropolitan markets in the nation.

TTU spans over 235 acres with an annual undergraduate and graduate enrollment of approximately 11,600 and CRMC serves as the regional medial center servicing the neighboring 14 counties.
