POPULATION


- Houston is the fourth-most populous city in the U.S. (7.34 million metro population)

- Within a 10-minute drive of the most affluent neighborhoods
- Within 4 miles of the city's highest income residences
- Most culturally diverse metro population in the nation

- 220,000 daily visitors to Downtown Houston
- 1.9 million annual visitors to the Theater District
- 11 million annual patrons of Downtown culture and entertainment venues
- 1.2 million nights booked annually in 24 hotels
- Minute Maid Park: 2.1 million annual visitors
- Toyota Center: 1.1 million annual visitors
- BBVA Compass Stadium: 350,000 annual visitors













FOOD HALL + PROPOSED EVENT SPACE
