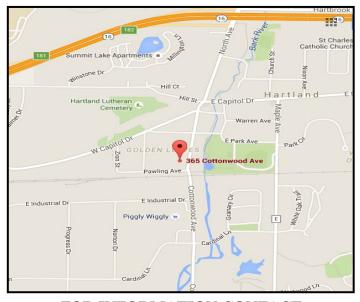

# **BROKER DISCLOSURE TO NON-RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS**

Prior to negotiating on your behalf the Broker must provide you the following disclosure statement:

#### 2 BROKER DISCLOSURE TO CUSTOMERS

- 3 You are a customer of the broker. The broker is either an agent of another party in the transaction or a subagent of another broker
- 4 who is the agent of another party in the transaction. The broker, or a salesperson acting on behalf of the broker, may provide
- 5 brokerage services to you. Whenever the broker is providing brokerage services to you, the broker owes you, the customer, the 6 following duties:
- 7 The duty to provide brokerage services to you fairly and honestly.
- 8 The duty to exercise reasonable skill and care in providing brokerage services to you.
- 9 The duty to provide you with accurate information about market conditions within a reasonable time if you request it, unless disclosure of the information is prohibited by law.
- 11 The duty to disclose to you in writing certain material adverse facts about a property, unless disclosure of the information is prohibited by law (See Lines 47-55).
- 13 The duty to protect your confidentiality. Unless the law requires it, the broker will not disclose your confidential information or the confidential information of other parties (See Lines 22-39).
- 15 The duty to safeguard trust funds and other property the broker holds.
- 16 The duty, when negotiating, to present contract proposals in an objective and unbiased manner and disclose the advantages and disadvantages of the proposals.
- Please review this information carefully. A broker or salesperson can answer your questions about brokerage services, but if you need legal advice, tax advice, or a professional home inspection, contact an attorney, tax advisor, or home inspector.
- This disclosure is required by section 452.135 of the Wisconsin statutes and is for information only. It is a plain-language summary of a broker's duties to a customer under section 452.133 (1) of the Wisconsin statutes.

- 29 1. MATERIAL ADVERSE FACTS. AS DEFINED IN SECTION 452.01 (5g) OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES (SEE LINES 47-55).
- 30 2. ANY FACTS KNOWN BY THE BROKER THAT CONTRADICT ANY INFORMATION INCLUDED IN A WRITTEN INSPECTION 31 REPORT ON THE PROPERTY OR REAL ESTATE THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE TRANSACTION.
- 32 TO ENSURE THAT THE BROKER IS AWARE OF WHAT SPECIFIC INFORMATION YOU CONSIDER CONFIDENTIAL, YOU MAY LIST 33 THAT INFORMATION BELOW (SEE LINES 35-36). AT A LATER TIME, YOU MAY ALSO PROVIDE THE BROKER WITH OTHER

#### 47 DEFINITION OF MATERIAL ADVERSE FACTS

48 Ā "material adverse fact" is defined in Wis. Stat. § 452.01(5g) as an adverse fact that a party indicates is of such significance, or that 49 is generally recognized by a competent licensee as being of such significance to a reasonable party, that it affects or would affect 50 the party's decision to enter into a contract or agreement concerning a transaction or affects or would affect the party's decision 51 about the terms of such a contract or agreement. An "adverse fact" is defined in Wis. Stat. § 452.01(1e) as a condition or occurrence 52 that a competent licensee generally recognizes will significantly and adversely affect the value of the property, significantly reduce 53 the structural integrity of improvements to real estate, or present a significant health risk to occupants of the property; or information 54 that indicates that a party to a transaction is not able to or does not intend to meet his or her obligations under a contract or
