History

Lakewood Shores Golf Resort From Farmland to Fairways

Lakewood Shores Golf Resort traces its roots to the early 1900s, when the land was known as Serradella Farms, owned by visionary agriculturist Carl E. Schmidt. By the late 1960s, the property evolved into a budding golf community named Lakewood Shores, complete with residential lots, a private course, and leisure amenities.

In 1986, entrepreneur Stan Aldridge acquired the struggling course and surrounding acreage. By 1990, he began transforming it into a full-fledged golf resort, introducing on-site lodging to enhance the guest experience. His son, Kevin Aldridge, brought a touch of Scotland to Michigan by designing The Gailes—a links-style course inspired by the rugged seaside layouts of the British Isles. The Gailes quickly earned national acclaim, and in 1993, Golf Digest crowned it the "#1 Best New Resort Course in the United States," marking a turning point in the resort's legacy.

OSCODA AREA HISTORY HIGHLIGHTS

- Founded in 1867: Originally platted by Smith, Kelley & Dwight.
- Name Origins: Coined by Henry Schoolcraft, blending Native American terms meaning "pebbly prairie."
- Military Legacy: Former site of Wurtsmith Air Force Base, a key Cold War installation decommissioned in 1993. Wurtsmith Air Force Base was once a Strategic Air Command base during the Cold War, now partially repurposed as Oscoda–Wurtsmith Airport.


Strengths

- Aging Infrastructure: Aside from the new 10,000 sf Club House in construction, hotel and banquet facilities have not been recently renovated, as they may fall behind newer resorts in appeal.

Threats

- Competitive Resorts: Albeit very limited, other Michigan resorts and national chains may offer more modern amenities or aggressive pricing.
- Economic Downturns: Travel and leisure spending is sensitive to economic shifts.
- Environmental Risks: Golf is seasonal, thus seeking additional revenue streams would maximize revenue lines. Michigan/Canadian weather events or lake-related issues could impact operations or guest experience.
