
New Hyde Park, New York

New Hyde Park, NY is an incorporated village located on Long Island within Nassau County. The village sits directly east of the New York City border (Queens) and offers convenient access to the Northern State Parkway and Cross Island Parkway. Residents commuting into NYC can access Grand Central Station in roughly 35 minutes via the local Long Island Railroad station. New Hyde Park had a reported population of 10,235 individuals with a median age of 41.7 and a median household income of \$144,375 according to 2022 census data. The 11-building Lake Success business park is one of Long Island's largest office complexes. Bordered by the Northern State Parkway, New Hyde Park Road and Marcus Avenue, Lake Success Quadrangle's current tenant roster includes ProHealth, Northwell Health, NYU Langone, Catholic Health Services, New York Cancer & Blood Specialist and many others. Both North Shore Community Hospital and Cohen Children's Medical Center are within a 10-minute driving distance of New Hyde Park.
