OVERVIEW

The Vaughn Building, built in 1958, was the third high rise office building in downtown Austin. The developers were two young friends and recent graduates of the University of Texas who would go on to serve the State as gubernatorial appointees to Agencies, Commissions, & Boards of Directors for more than half a century. The Vaughn Building's history is steeped in politics and government affairs including offices of many Judges, Commissioners, United States Senators and Congressmen, Governors of Texas, Presidents of the United States, and the campaigns of scores of others seeking or achieving elective office. Many officeholders who would go on to gain prominence began their careers at 807 Brazos, just two blocks from the State Capitol and adjoining the Federal Building complex. The Vaughn Building will always endure as a landmark of historical events in Texas public service.
