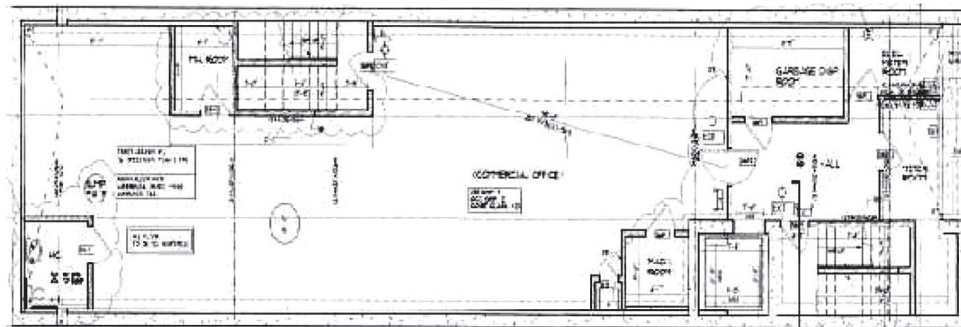

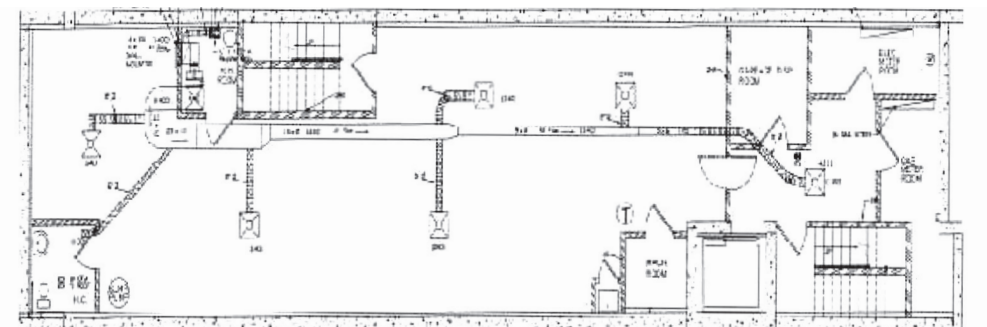

Adam Clayton Powell Jr. Boulevard is one of Harlem's most iconic streets, running through the heart of the neighborhood in Manhattan. It's named after the influential politician and civil rights leader Adam Clayton Powell Jr. It runs north-south through the heart of Harlem, starting from 110th Street near Central Park and stretching up to 155th Street, at the border of Washington Heights. The boulevard is a vibrant part of Harlem, lined with a mix of residential buildings, small businesses, and cultural landmarks. The architecture along the street includes classic Harlem brownstones and more modern developments, reflecting the neighborhood's ongoing evolution.

The area has a rich musical heritage, with historic venues like the Apollo Theater just a few blocks away. There's a mix of old and new, with trendy restaurants, soul food spots, art galleries, and local shops coexisting alongside traditional institutions like churches and community centers.

The combination of its history and its lively present makes Adam Clayton Powell Jr. Boulevard a kind of heartbeat for Harlem.

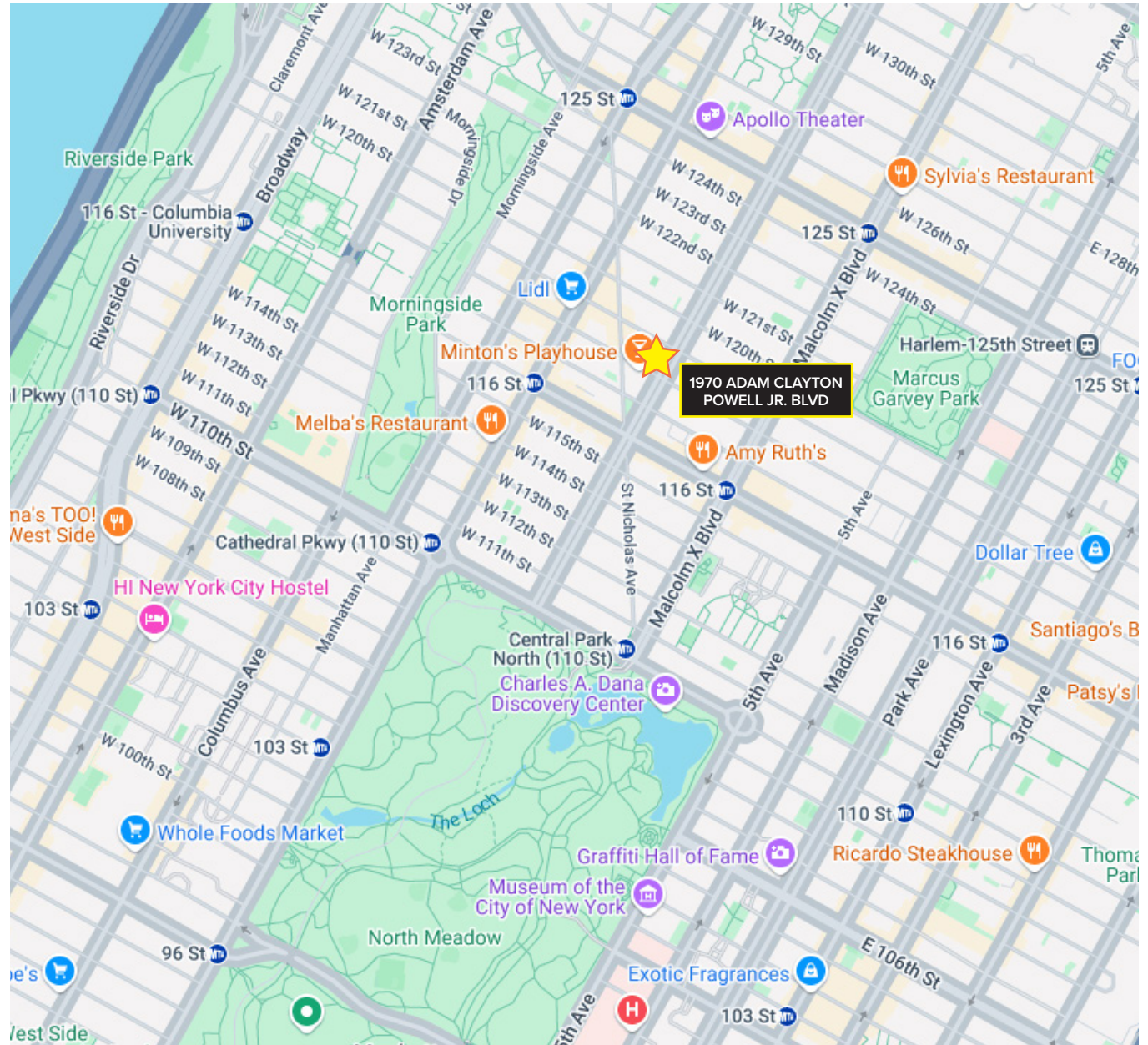
