





Traffic Count Map

Currently, 63.1% of the 12,839 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 20.1%, renter occupied; and 16.8% are vacant. 




Trends 2025-2030




Population by Age




Penitas 2025 2835-2981 W US Highway 83, Mission, Texas, 78572 Ring band: 1 - 3 mile radius




Trends 2025-2030




Population by Age




Penitas 2025 2835-2981 W US Highway 83, Mission, Texas, 78572 Ring band: 3 - 5 mile radius









Population by Age
