Building Description

240 Union Station Plaza is a two story 25,289 square foot former train station which was built in 1924 that replaced a previous train depot. The building was completely renovated into a single-tenant office building in 2002-2003. Further renovations occurred in 2015. Current occupant is prepared to address a shortterm sale leaseback scenario.

The interior is currently utilized as a single tenant space on two floors. There is the opportunity to subdivide the space for multiple tenants or for an adaptive reuse. The main lobby on the first floor has one primary and five secondary entrances along with a stairwell to the second floor and a grand stairwell to the mostly unfinished basement. The exterior of the building is primarily a brick finish with accented areas of different textures. The property is situated on an irregular shaped lot consisting of 2.23 acres. The northern portion of the building is adjacent to an active rail line. The property resides within Keystone Innovation Zone (KIZ) and the current zoning is Central Business District (CBD).
