**PROPERTY OVERVIEW**

Three outparcels of 0.86 ACs, 0.91 ACs, & 1.17 ACs are now available for sale shadow anchoring a Food Lion Shopping Center. Water & sewer are available off Cliffdale Rd. Sites are level and ready to be developed.

The intersection of Cliffdale & Reilly Rds recently received an uptick in traffic due to the road closure at S Reilly Rd leading towards Fort Bragg Military Base. Today, all base personnel arriving from or returning to the Western part of Fayetteville & Hoke County pass this center everyday. Traffic is slated to increase with the opening of the I-295 Outer Loop Cliffdale Rd exit less than a mile up the road. This area will now be accessible to all areas of Fayetteville and I-95. Developers have taken notice and are building residential housing and multifamily rapidly in the area.

There are over 43,000 residents living within a three mile radius whose average household income exceeds \$62,000. There are currently 31,000 vehicles passing this site daily, which is only slated to increase with the opening of I-295 on Cliffdale Rd leading to the gates of Fort Bragg.

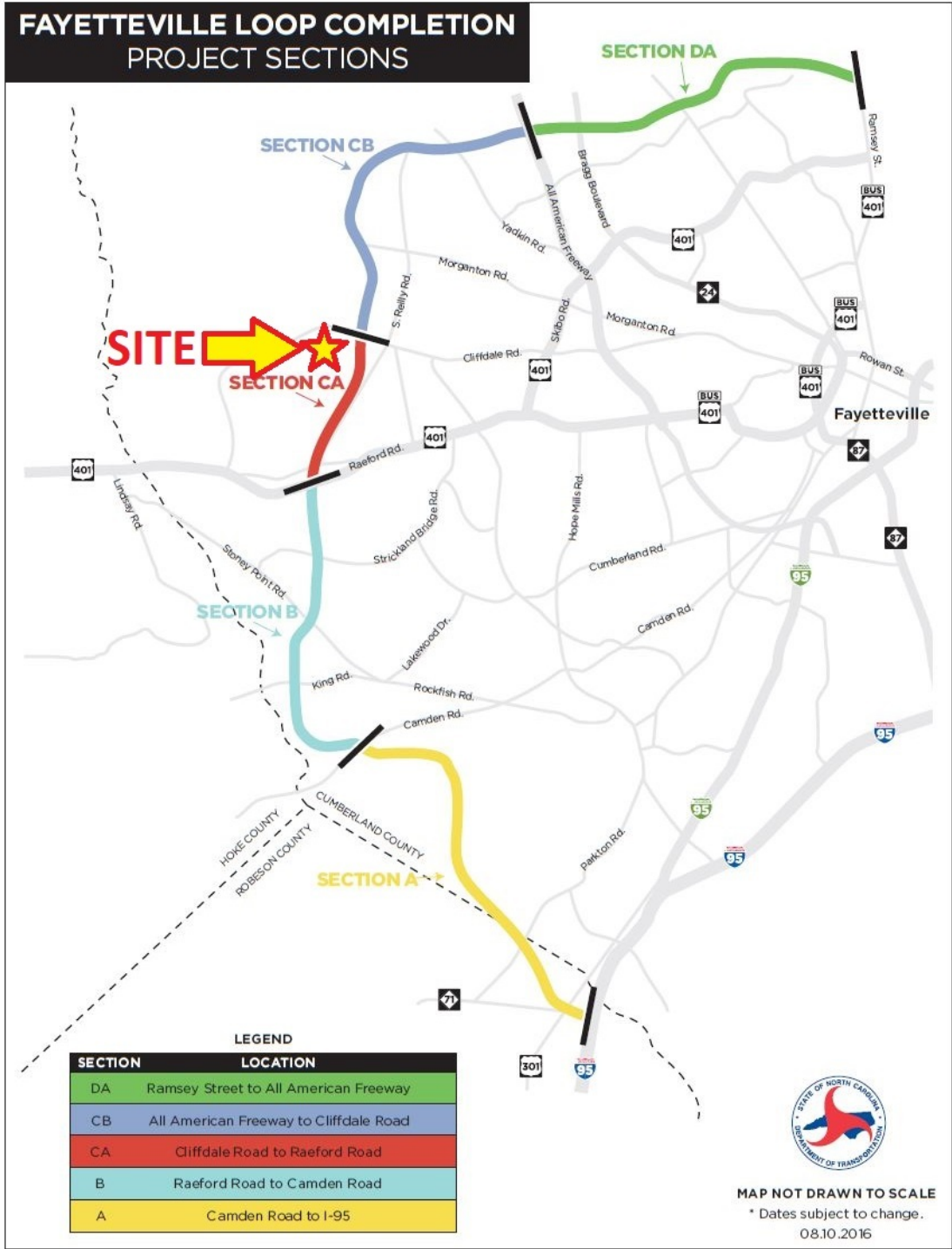


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295 OUTER LOOP MAP

Currently, 43.4% of the 45,922 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 45.0%, renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 41,492 housing units in the area - 50.2% owner occupied, 40.9% renter occupied, and 8.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.61%. Median home value in the area is \$138,556, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.47% annually to \$149,013.
