


"A SANCTUARY FOR VISIONARIES AND INNOVATORS"









PRINCIPAL FLOORS








FURNISHED SPACE






RESTAURANT

NATURAL FORCES WITHIN US ARE THE TRUE HEALERS OF DISEASE




ROOF GARDEN


This sanctuary combines the tranquility of verdant trees and the fragrant scents of jasmine, lavender, and fresh herbs.


First Floor




Second Floor




Third Floor

Broadway once hosted the highest concentration of movie palaces on the planet. At it's peak in the early 1900s, 80% of the world's movies were shot in California, which contributed to Los Angeles becoming the entertainment capital of the world.
