Delivery Voltage

South Central Power Company maintains three-phase distribution facilities on-site at Shepard Road with approximately 1MW feeder capacity.

Primary and Secondary Substations

The primary substation feeding this site is the Lockbourne Substation feeder 3 approximately 0.75 miles north of the site. The secondary substation for this site is the Midway Substation approximately 0.75 miles northeast of the site.

Transmission Infrastructure

There is a 138kV transmission line on-site maintained by AEP Transmission that would be utilized by South Central Power Company.

Outage History

Below is a summary of outages in 2021 & 2022.

o 2021: Substation: 19 | Feeder 3: 13 o 2022: Substation: 47 | Feeder 3: 31

Extensive improvements have been completed with additional substation improvements commissioned in 2022. This area has been significantly strengthened to improve reliability.

Dual Feed Availability

South Central Power Company would likely recommend a dual feed from the Midway Substation described in 5.1.2, however a completed system analysis would be required with AEP Transmission and South Central Power to provide a detailed plan of service.

Service Capacity & Existing Customers

The on-site facilities being fed from the Lockbourne Substation have ~1MW of feeder capacity. While there is not presently a redundant feeder circuit on-site from the Midway Substation, there is currently ~7MVA of available capacity at the station. The on-site three-phase facilities are utilized primarily for residential, with limited commercial/industrial use.




