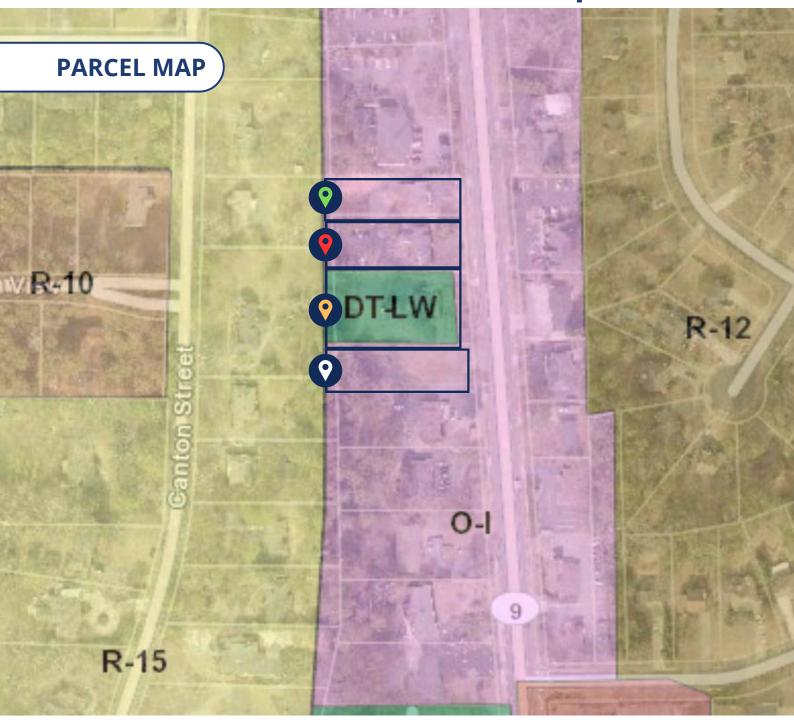

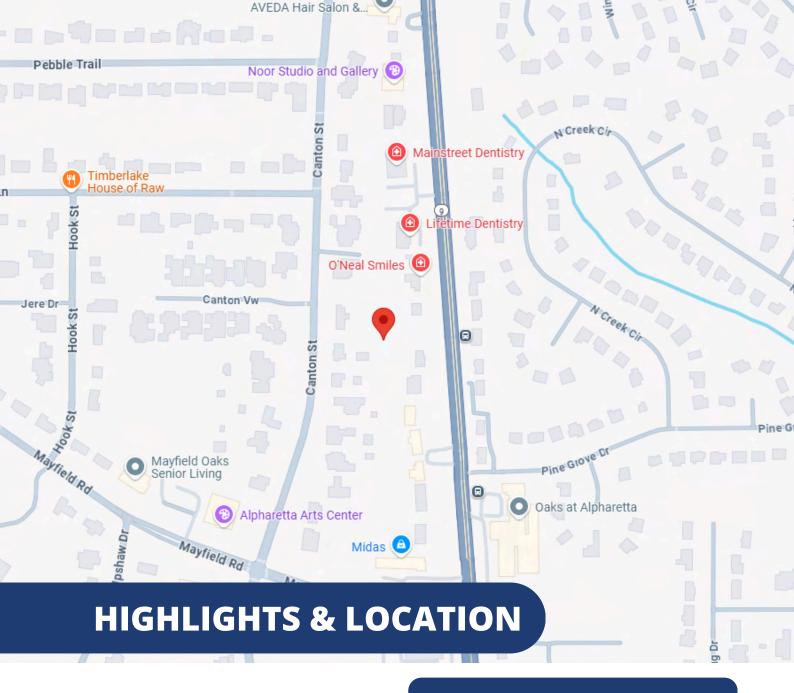

LOCATION ADVANTAGES

- ✓ **Downtown Walkability:** Just steps from Alpharetta City Center and under 5 minutes to Avalon—offering retail, dining, office space, and events.
- ✓ **Excellent Access:** Approx. 2 miles to GA-400 via Exit 10; Main Street frontage with high visibility. Future streetscape plans include 12-ft multi-use sidewalks and on-street parking.

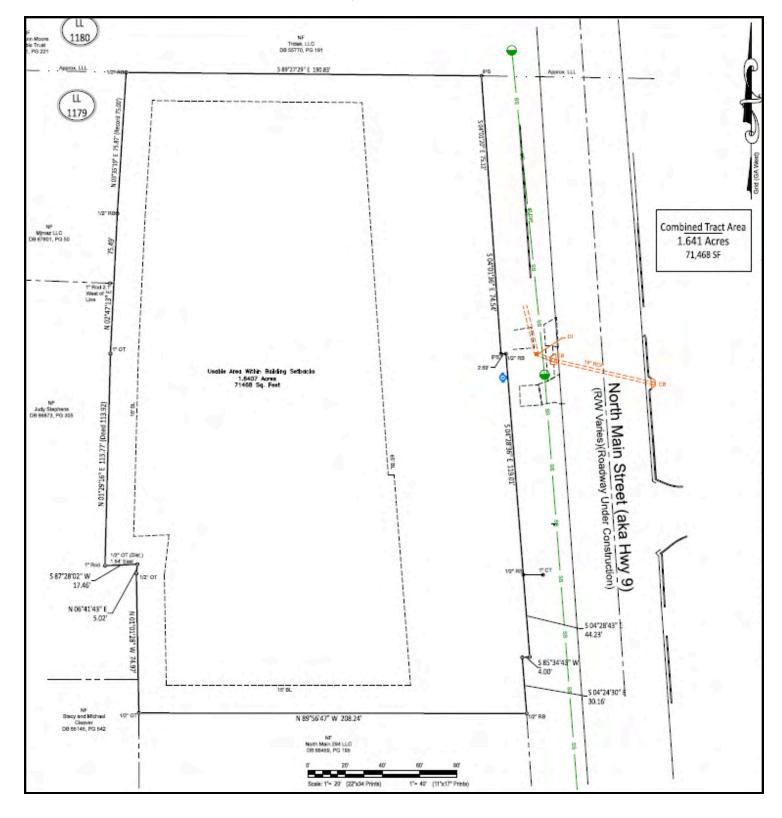
- ✓ **Four-Parcel Assemblage:** Offered together as a combined footprint of 1.64+/- acres (71,481 SF +/-).
- ✓ Future Zoning: DT-LW (Downtown overlay Live Work) allows flexible commercial / residential uses including retail, office, townhomes, or multifamily.
- ✓ **Topography:** All lots are mostly leveled and development shovel-ready.

Infrastructure & Easements

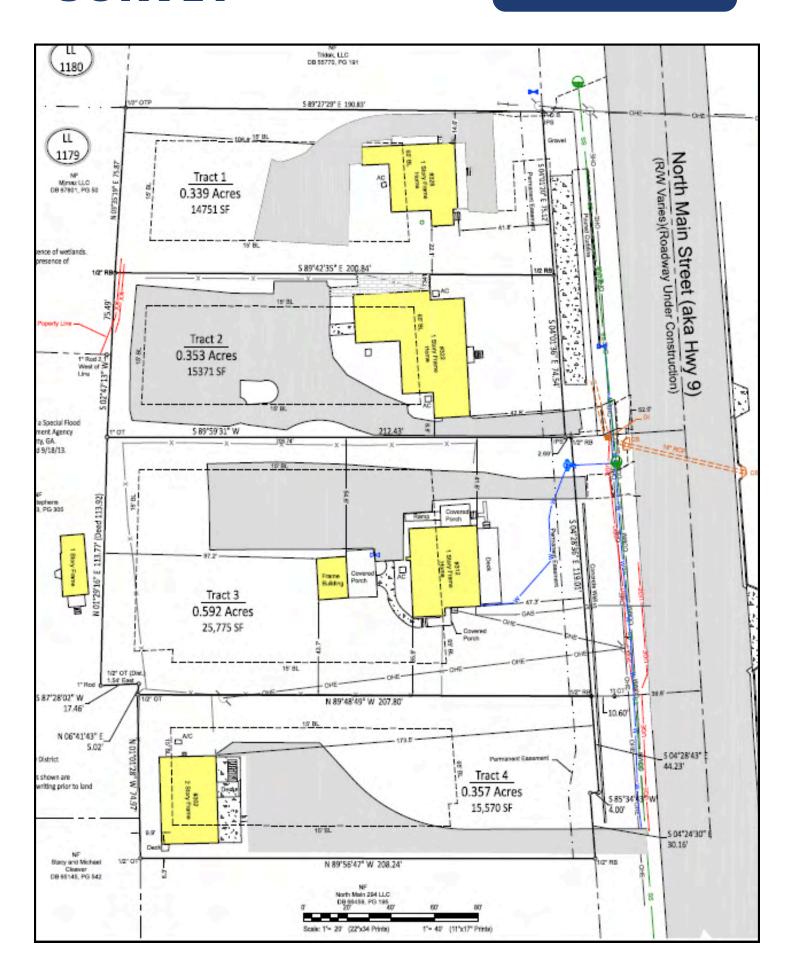
- Right-of-Way/Easement Activity: Utilities (water, electric, telecom) run along the eastern edge (N Main frontage).
- Minor permanent access & utility easements along driveways and utility paths—should be verified during civil engineering.
- No known flood zone issues noted (as per FEMA statement).

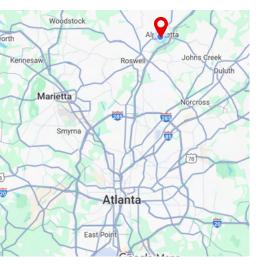


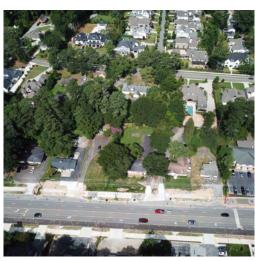

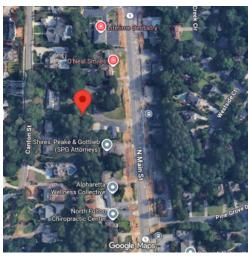
APROX. BOUNDARY LINES





















REDEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL



Ideal for Mixed-Use or Residential:

Prime for boutique residential or mixed-use with retail below and residences / office above. Foot traffic and Main St exposure support strong demand.

With aprox. 71,467 sq ft total site area and 70% lot coverage, aprox. 50,027 sq ft may be used for impervious surfaces (building, driveways, etc).

OTHER PROJECTS IN THE AREA PROGRESS



Alpha at Main (236 & 244 N Main Street)

Description: Consideration of a rezoning from O-I (Office-Institutional) to DT-LW (Downtown Live-Work) and a variance to reduce the side setback between structures from 10' to 6' in order to allow for the construction of 11 single-family detached homes in the Downtown.

116 & 126 N Main Street

Description: Consideration of a rezoning and variances to allow for 2, 4-story mixed-use buildings on 1.43 acres. The mix of uses includes 32,000 square feet of office, 4,000 square feet of restaurant and 4 'For-Sale' condominium units.
