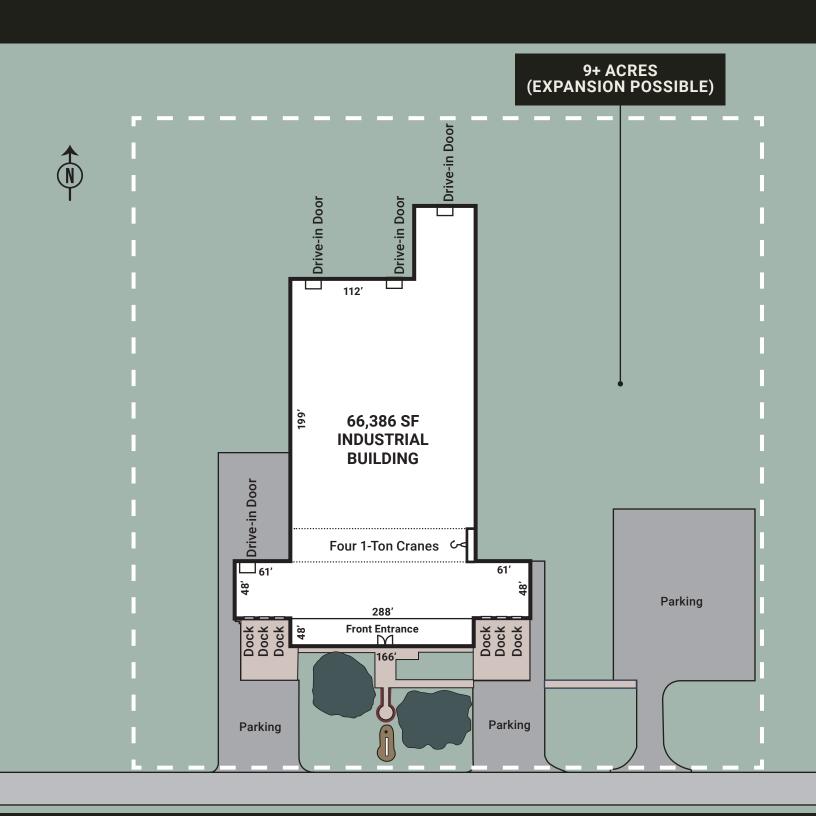

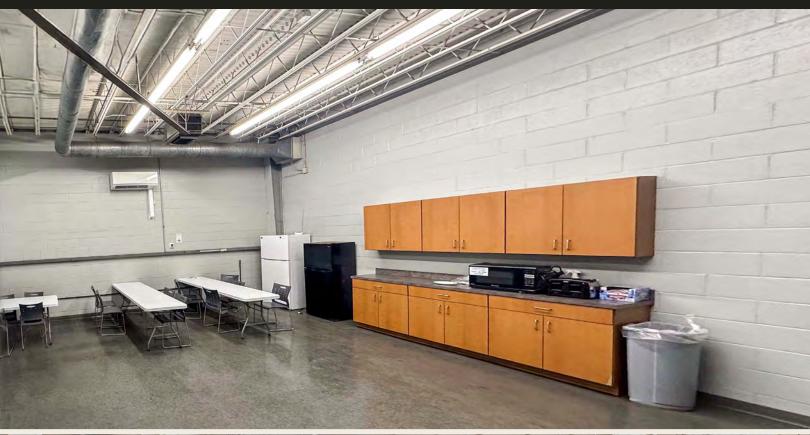

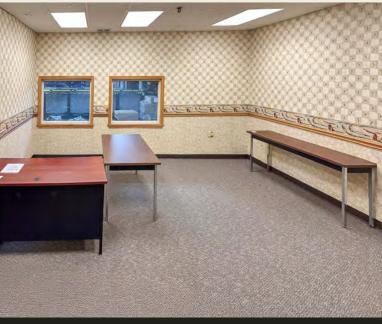

53 North Industrial Park

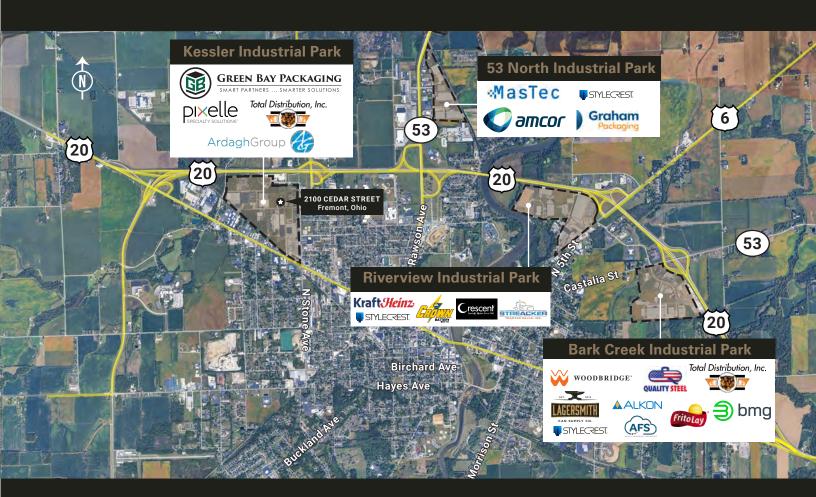

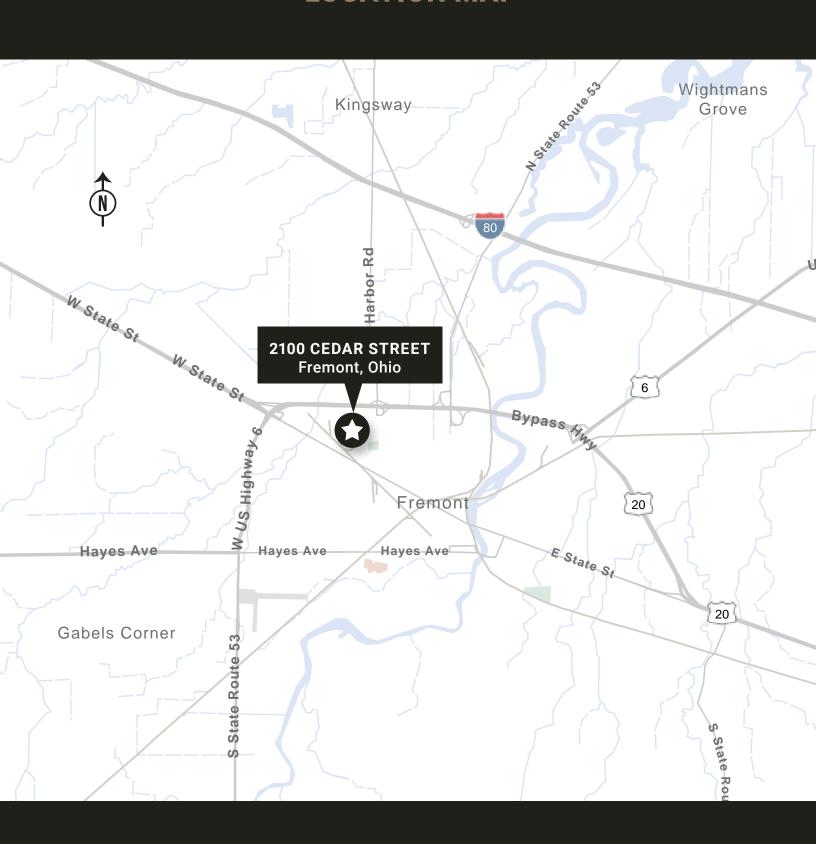

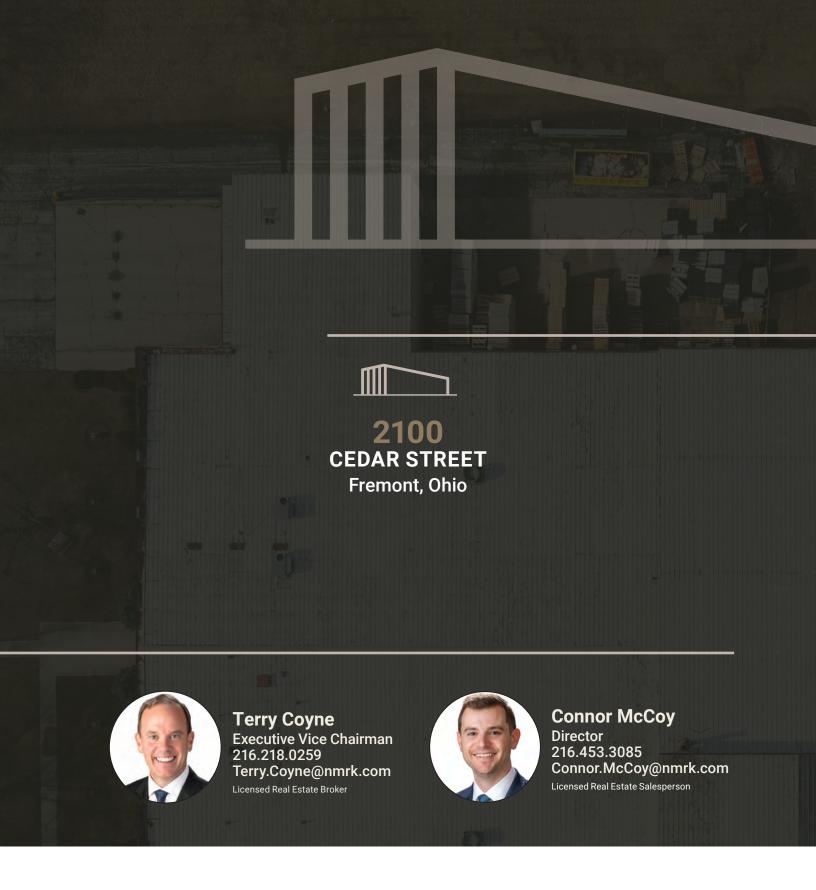




LOCATION MAP -
