The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 75.1 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 9,573 in the specified area.

The Gini index measures the extent to which the distribution of income or consumption among individuals or households within an economy deviates from a perfectly equal distribution. Currently, 58.0% of the 14,767 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 35.5%, renter occupied; and 6.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 14,506 housing units in the area and 6.6% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.42%. Median home value in the area is \$148,948, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.83% annually to \$163,056.

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
