



Eureka is located in Humboldt County, the heart of California's beautiful Redwood Coast in the northwestern portion of the state. The coastal location and world-famous redwood forests combine to create a region of natural beauty that attracts thousands of visitors each year. The historic seaport town of Eureka is also an attractive destination for tourists.

Just 6 miles north of Eureka is the home of the state's newest California Polytechnic University, Cal Poly Humboldt. 25 miles off shore is a Federal lease site for wind energy production and just across the bay are the headquarters for the proposed land-based fish farm. There has never been a more exciting time to invest in Eureka, CA.





Eureka is the largest coastal city between San Francisco and Portland, Oregon. It is also the principal city and county seat of Humboldt County. It is the regional center for government, healthcare and the arts on the North Coast.

California's North Coast has a diversified economy which includes light manufacturing, timber, fishing and agriculture. Greater Eureka is one of the state's major commercial fishing ports. Humboldt Bay is the largest deep water port between San Francisco and Coos Bay, Oregon.
