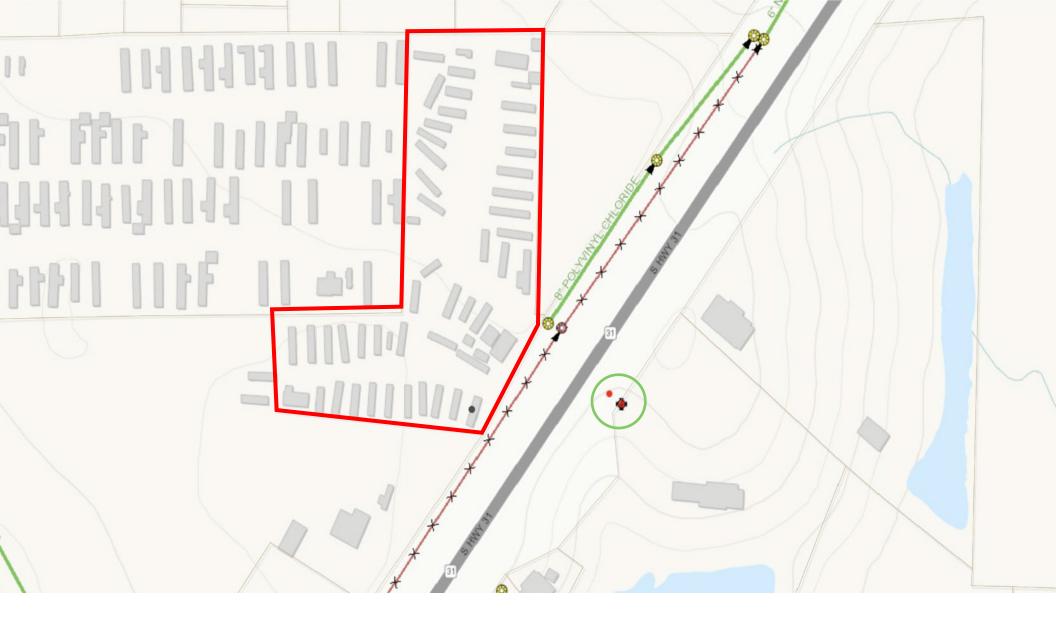




POTENTIAL USE

The previous mobile home park has been closed for 3 years.

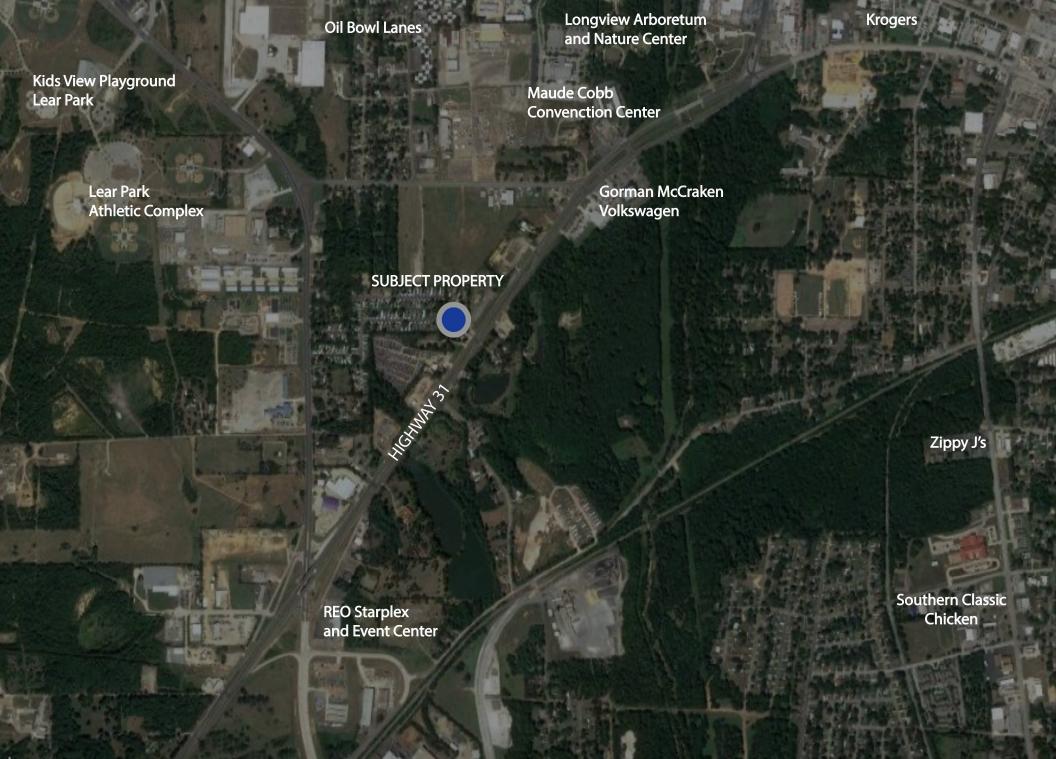
