Several wineries are located throughout this Northern Virginia region, the Virginia Wine Trail featuring two prominent wineries: Cooper Vineyards and the Lake Anna. The regular wine tasting events held throughout the season offer a lovely way to sample a selection of local vintages. Finedining establishments and numerous casual restaurants also draw visitors from both Washington, DC and Richmond. Pleasants Landing is a choice location for company picnics, family reunions, and church gatherings. The Lake Anna Sunset Concert series also draws large crowds during the summer, as well as numerous sports events. The lake's economy continues to grow, the local demographics (see table below) are largely upper-middle class.
