








AERIAL MAP







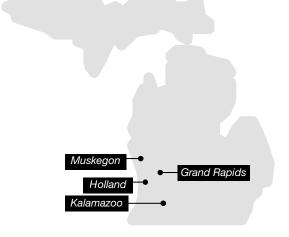
LOCATION OVERVIEW
