

MARTIN KY (ZIP 41649) FLOYD COUNTY KY LOCATION

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Subject: **Traffic Counts around Martin, KY (ZIP 41649) Floyd County, Ky because Martin KY sits at the confluence of KY-80, KY-122, and KY-1428 covering and the 2nd largest bank deposit center in Floyd County outside the County Seat, Prestonsburg, Ky 41653**

Date: September 15, 2025

Background

City of Martin (ZIP 41649) Floyd County KY provides long-term service planning and community access, Martin sits at the confluence of KY-80, KY-122, and KY-1428 these junctions are at or near OUR BUILDING AND PROPERTY in Martin, KY.

The following summary relies on KYTC traffic counts (CTS/DataMart) and the KYTC Floyd County traffic station map provided.

Traffic summary (KYTC counts — verified / provided)

- **KY-80 (Sta: 507 YR24) & (Sta: 007 YR24) — one-way** counts reported as **9,281 – 10,237** respectively AADT vehicles per day one direction.
 - Converting to two-way: $9,281 \times 2 = 18,562$ and $10,237 \times 2 = 20,474$ vehicles/day. (**Two-way AADT \approx 18,562 – 20,474**).
 - *Note:* these one-way figures were provided from the KYTC counts you referenced; they imply KY-80 carries traffic volumes comparable to major corridors in the area.
- **KY-1428 (Sta: 513 YR23) — 3,297** vehicles/day (AADT, two-way traffic).
- **KY-122 (Sta: 506 YR24) & (Sta:C06 YR22 at McDonald's) — 2,358 & 5,729** respectively vehicles/day (AADT, two-way traffic).
- **US-23 (Allen area)** — US-23 is a high-volume divided highway serving through traffic; CTS/DataMart station(s) on US-23 show substantially higher overall volumes in the corridor (see CTS for the exact station near Allen).

Interpretation — why Martin is the better location for Floyd County, Ky

1. **KY-80 is a major community-serving corridor.**
 - The one-way KY-80 counts cited (9,281–10,237) convert to two-way AADT of **18,562–20,474**, which is **comparable to or exceeds** many regional corridors.

That level of two-way traffic indicates KY-80 is not merely a low-volume local road — it is a significant corridor that directly serves Martin and nearby side hollows.

2. **Martin is the local junction for community access.**

- Martin sits at the confluence of **KY-80, KY-122, and KY-1428**. While US-23 (Allen) is a higher-speed through route, Martin's state highways are the **actual direct access routes for 41649 businesses, residents and nearby surrounding counties**. Placing your business in Martin reduces travel time/mileage for businesses and residents who live off the feeder roads.

3. **Operational efficiency for Servicing Eastern Kentucky.**

- With KY-80 carrying the traffic volumes reported, mail carriers and various delivery service vehicles already operate along this route. A location at Martin, Ky places your business operations directly on a high-volume state corridor, reducing detours and backtracking all directions surrounding Floyd County communities and other Eastern Ky surrounding counties.

4. **Community & equity considerations.**

- Locating our business in Martin KY helps maintain community identity and provides equitable service to other businesses and residents who otherwise must detour onto US-23 and travel further from their direct feeder routes.

Recommendation

Locate your business in Martin, KY (41649) Floyd County, KY as your permanent business location. KYTC traffic counts show KY-80 near Martin is a major corridor (one-way 9,281–10,237 → two-way ≈ 18,562–20,474), and Martin's junction of three state routes makes it the most logical, accessible location to serve the 41649 community.
