

ABOUT SUNRIVER, OREGON

POPULATION: 1,516
County: Deschutes County

Sunriver has been one of Oregon's favorite getaways for nearly half a century. The resort community 16 miles south of Bend has been recognized as a recreational and vacation destination since the 1960s, equally perfect for snowy ski excursions and sunny summer holidays. The beautiful location is situated near a few of the best outdoor recreation spots in Central Oregon, like the Deschutes River, the Mt. Bachelor ski area, and several nearby state parks. meandering Deschutes River in a thick forest of pine shelters a wide variety of activities for all seasons.

From January 2021 to December 2022, there were 17,025 visitors that have travelled to Sunriver for recreation or other activities. Of these visitors, 82.8% were repeat visitors. The mean household income of these visitors is \$118,901.

In 2022, Sunriver, OR had a population of 1,516 people with a median age of 70.2 and a median household income of \$87,276. Between 2021 and 2022 the population of Sunriver, OR declined from 1,530 to 1,516, a -0.915% decrease and its median household income grew from \$78,241 to \$87,276, a 11.5% increase. In 2022, the median property value in Sunriver, OR was \$637,300, and the homeownership rate was 87.7%.
