Emergency Power: Normal power from two geographically diverse ducts; additional capacity available

Elevators: 30 passenger elevators and three freight elevators

Parking: In building, floors 2-5

Tenant metering: Some tenant spaces are directly metered by PSE&G, and some submetered

Building hours of operation: 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Security: 24/7 building security
