






Section Two: Floor Plan



CALIFORNIA'S FASTEST-GROWING METROPOLITAN AREA

Sacramento is the Capitol of California, the fourth largest economy in the world. While perhaps not considered as prolific as many of the tourism-based cities in California such as San Francisco, Los Angeles and San Diego, being the hub of California's governmental structure provides an incredible amount of economic stability throughout the region. In addition, Sacramento is being increasingly recognized as an outdoor enthusiast's dream city with its remarkably central location to Lake Tahoe, the Sierra's, Yosemite and the Coast.

In a recent study completed by WalletHub for National Nutrition Month. Sacramento was ranked the 5th healthiest city in the United States among 100 large cities (ranking higher than the likes of Denver. Colorado Springs. San Francisco, Portland, Austin, San Antonio and Seattle). Forbes magazine ranked Sacramento as the 10th healthiest city in the United States versus all cities. A big part of this recognition stems from the cities' proximity to the American River. Hiking trails and white-water rafting abound along the American River as well as one of Sacramento's crown jewels - the 32-mile American River Bike Trail which runs entirely along the river from Beal's State Park to Discovery Park where it conjoins with the Sacramento River to Old Sacramento on the riverfront (a stone's throw from the Subject Property).


















