





Prime Positioning

Ocala has emerged as a key distribution center for diverse industries, leveraging its strong connectivity to major Florida metropolitan areas and strategic access to Interstate 75—a critical transportation artery that handles the majority of incoming freight traffic to the region.

Distribution Excellence

Leading corporations are increasingly integrating Ocala into their logistics networks. The market currently hosts more than 23 million sf of warehouse and distribution facilities, supporting over 24,700 workers in transportation, warehousing, and supply chain operations.

Drive Times

Convenient access to a network of rail and interstate highway systems, and a thriving manufacturing industry makes Ocala a prime location for distribution and logistics centers. Ocala's central Florida location reaches 34 million people in a 6 hour drive-time. This is a 39% greater population reach than the I-4 corridor.


