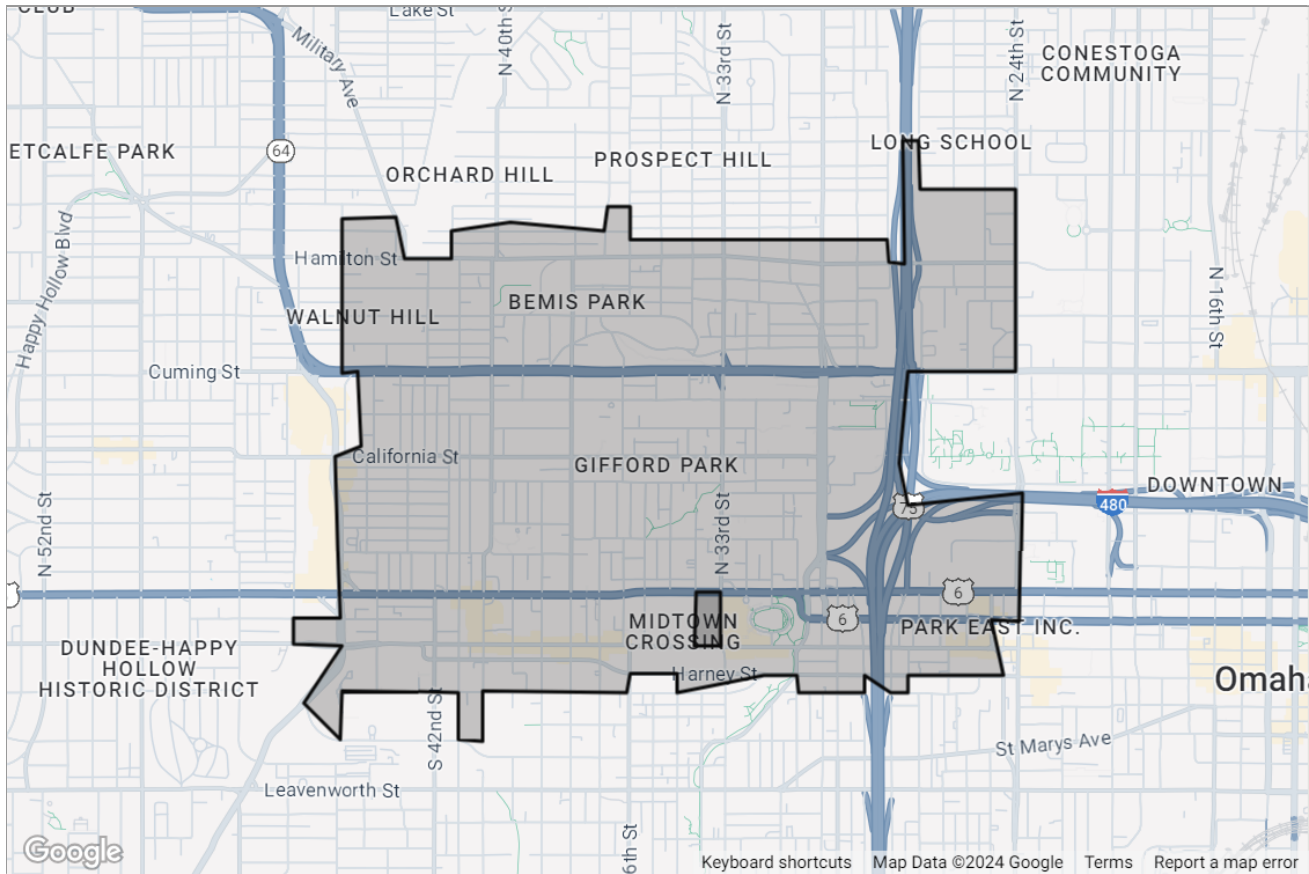

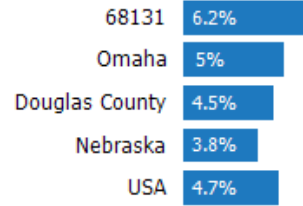

This chart shows the educational achievement levels of adults in an area, compared with other geographies.

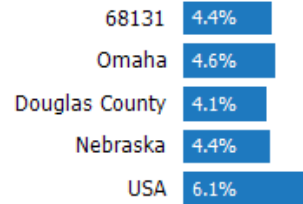

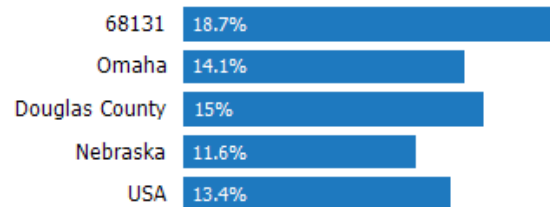

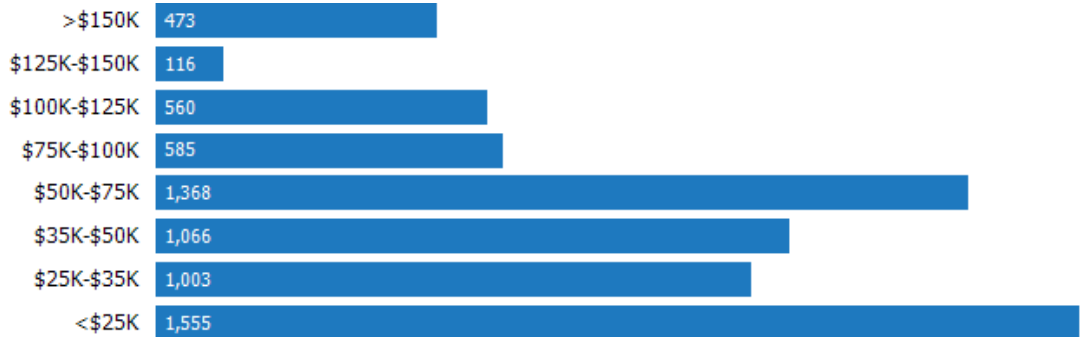
## Household Income Brackets

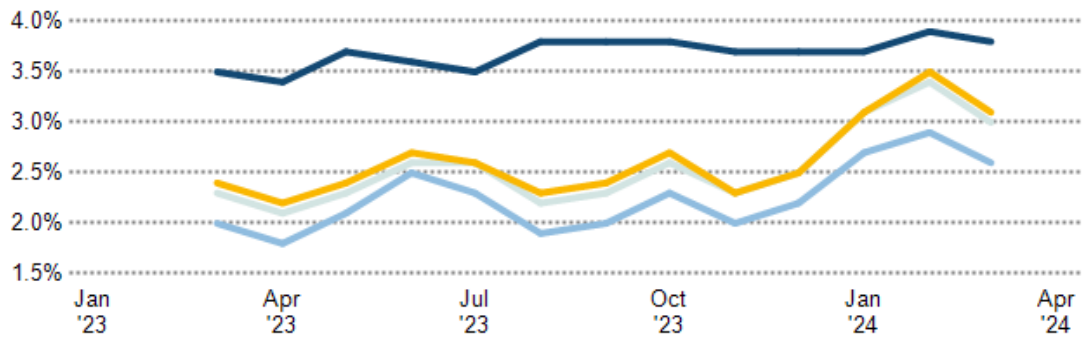
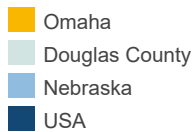

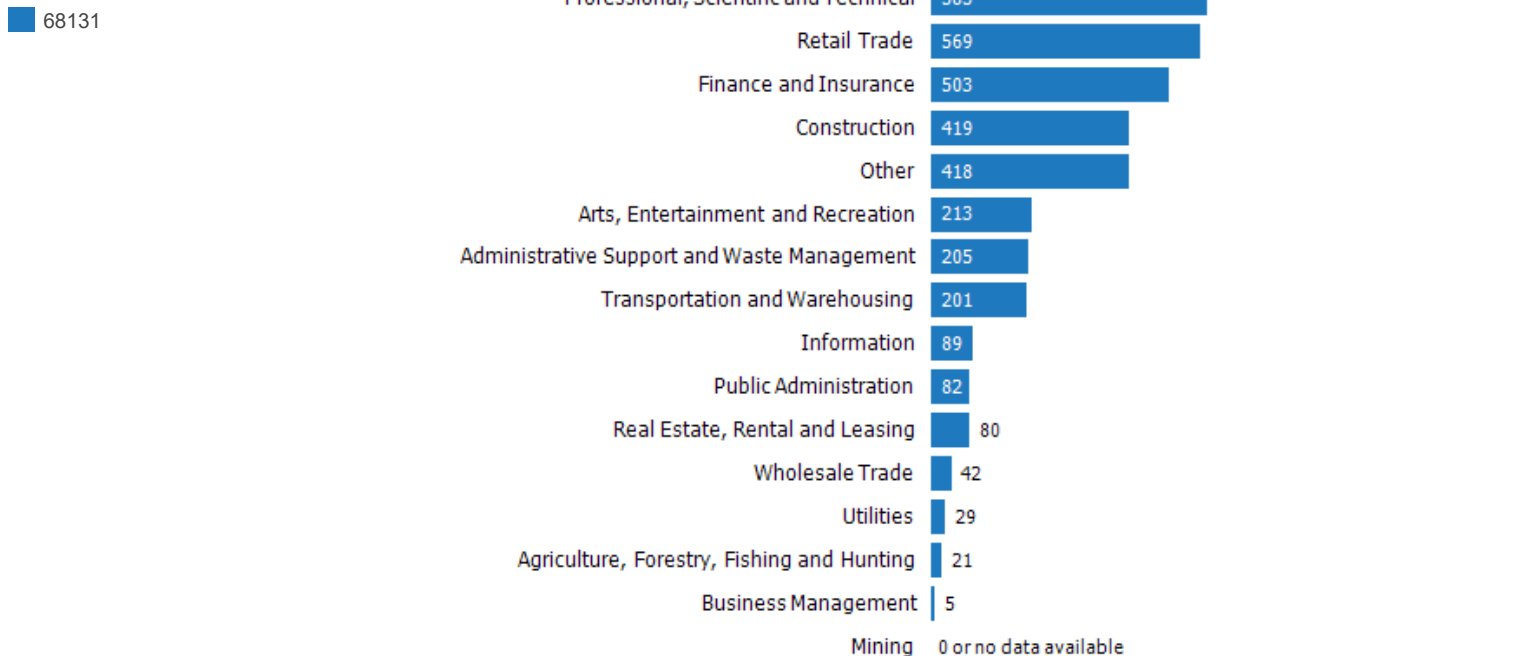

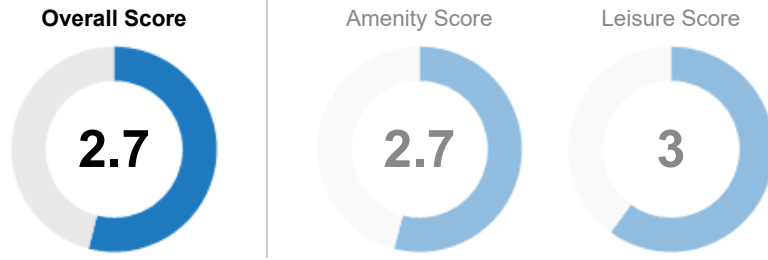

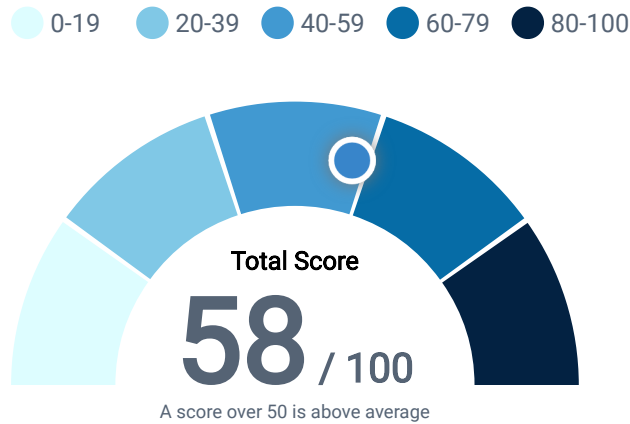


## AARP Livability™ Index for 68131
