



Cuatro at City Heights

Cuatro at City Heights, a \$98 million project in San Diego’s Mid-City, is set to transform the neighborhood with 117 residential units and 13,000 square feet of mixed-use space. Located at 4050 University Avenue, this development will provide new community hubs. By repurposing long-vacant lots, Cuatro will offer amenities such as bicycle parking, laundry facilities, outdoor courtyards, and recreational areas. Expected to open by fall 2025, the project is a major milestone in creating a safer, cleaner, and more prosperous City Heights.


Where Diversity Inspires
