Property Overview

The main level offers approximately 1,358 SF of space, including a reception and waiting area, two large private offices (either suitable as a conference room), two additional flex/work areas, and a restroom.

The upstairs loft provides an additional 461 SF of flexible space, complete with a full bathroom, kitchenette/break area, and utility/tech room—ideal for storage, creative workspace, or executive use.

The current zoning classification, LCC (Linear Commercial Corridor, Unincorporated Polk County) allows for a multitude of uses, including professional office, personal service, which would be conducive to the Office Park.

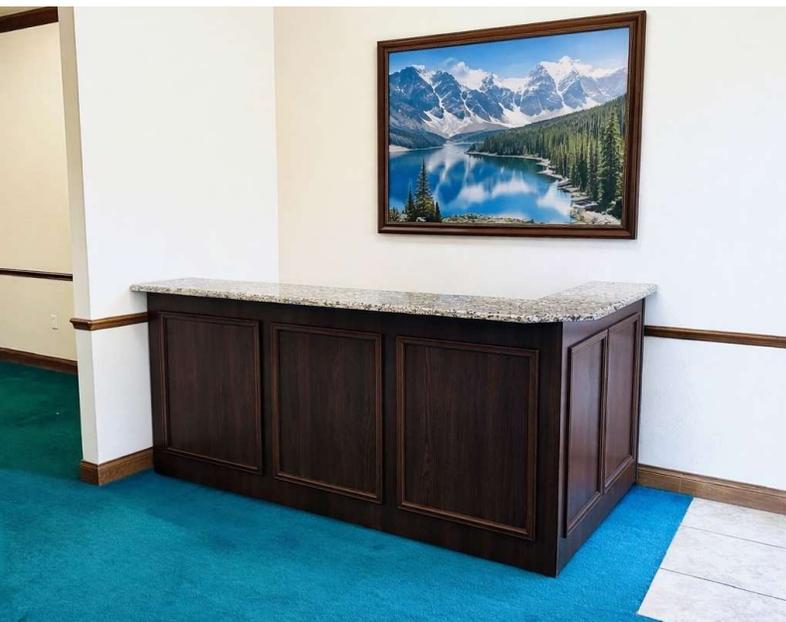

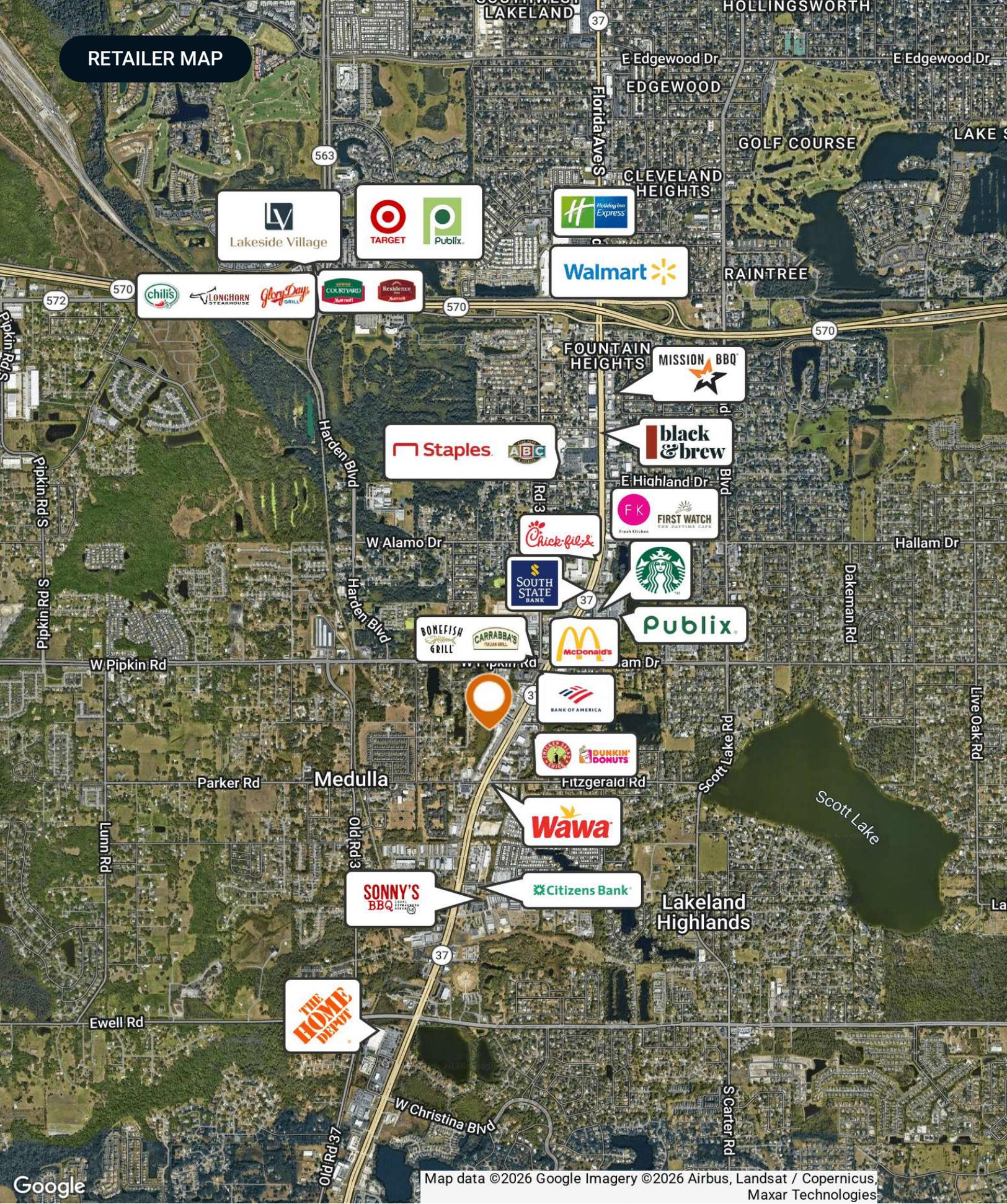

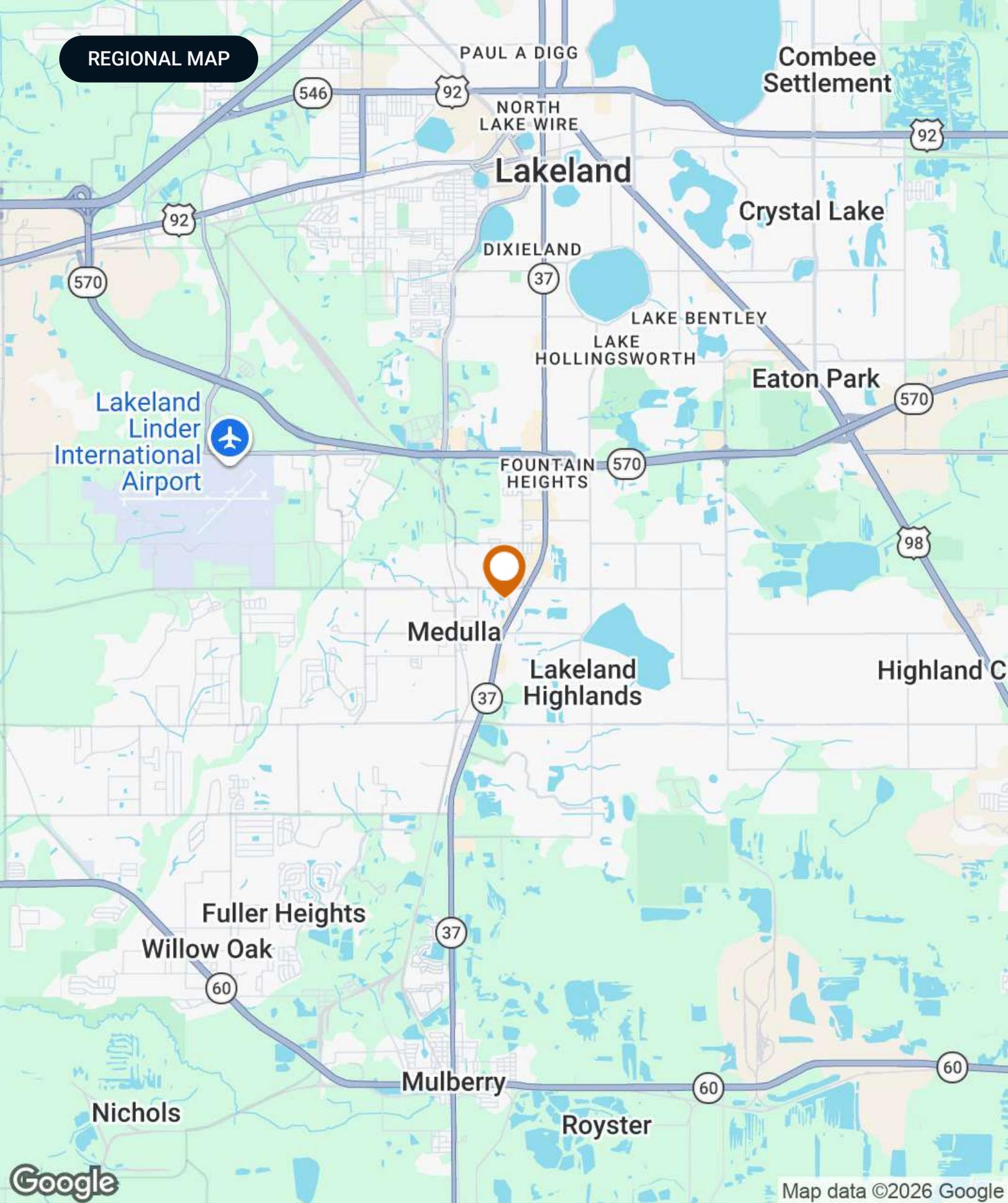


RETAILER MAP

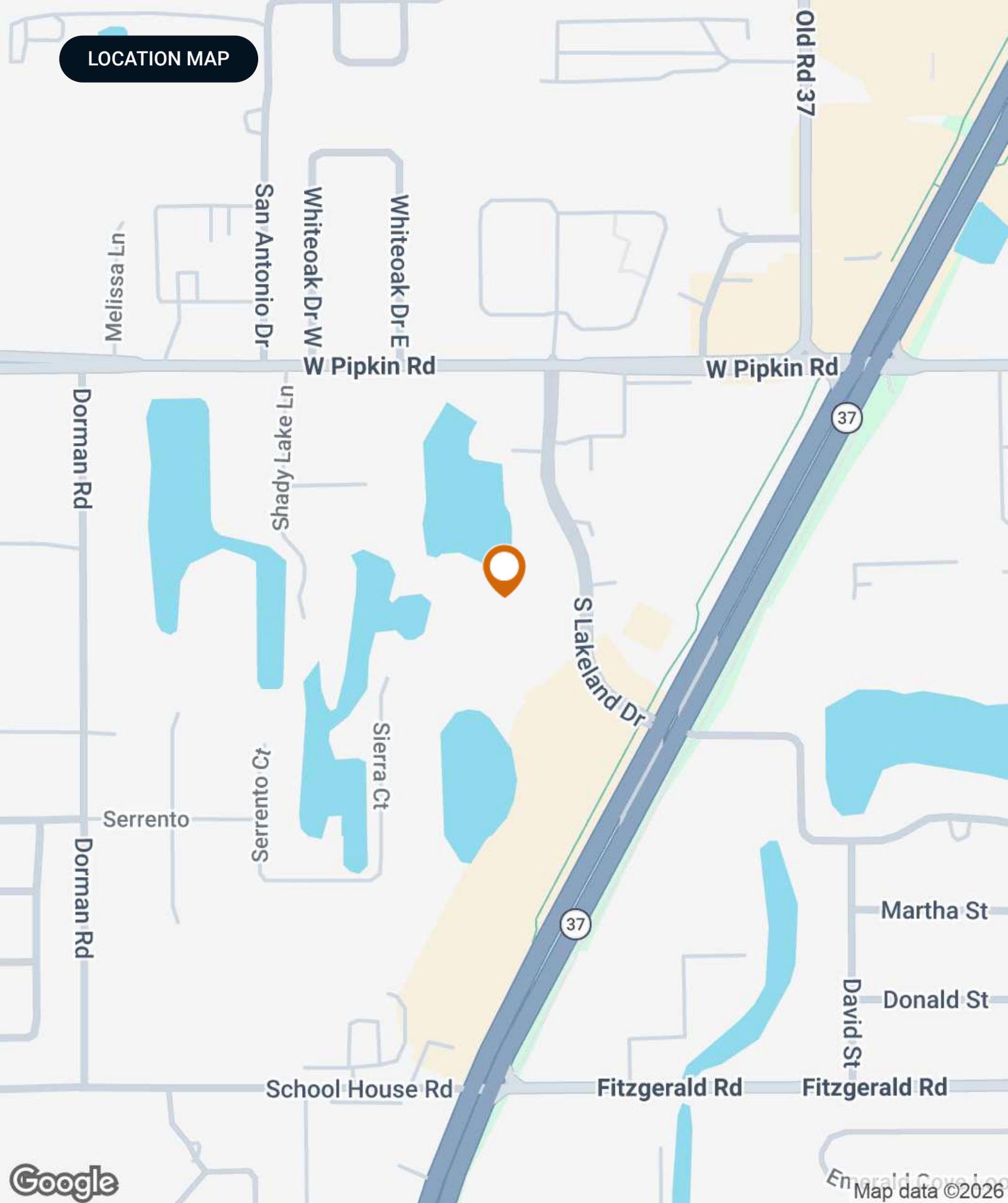


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REGIONAL MAP



LOCATION MAP

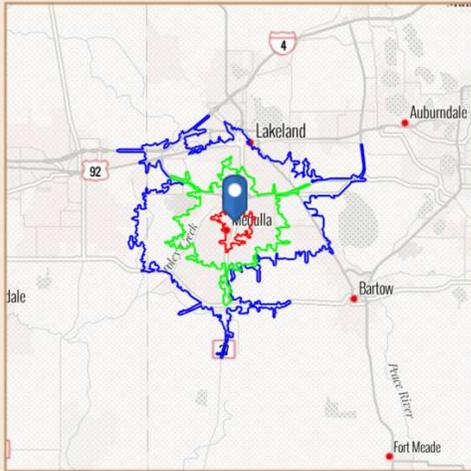
