

THE CHICO AREA

Chico is the fastest growing city in the state of California. It is the most populous city in Butte County, which is at the northeast edge of the Sacramento Valley.

As of the 2010 United States Census, the population was 86,187, reflecting an increase of 26,233 from the 59,954 counted in the 2000 Census. Following the 2018 Camp Fire that destroyed much of the neighboring town of Paradise, the population of Chico surged as many people who lost their homes in the fire moved to Chico. In 2019, the US Census estimated the population of Chico is 103,30 and more than 120,000 in the Greater Chico Urban Area..

The city is the cultural, economic, and educational center of the northern Sacramento Valley and home to California State University, Chico, Sierra Nevada Brewing Company, and Bidwell Park, the country's 26th largest municipal park and the 13th largest municipally-owned park.
