



San Carlos Profile

San Carlos is located in San Mateo County on the San Francisco Peninsula, nestled between Belmont to the north and Redwood City to the south. It spans approximately 5.4 square miles and is entirely urban, with no rural areas. The city enjoys a mild Mediterranean climate and is known for its scenic hills, tree-lined streets, and proximity to the San Francisco Bay.

San Carlos, also known as the "City of Good Living", is a small city with a quaint downtown scene that revolves around Laurel Street and El Camino Real. Boutique restaurants and shops owned by local residents occupy most of the spaces, which creates a wider variety of restaurants aside from the usual fast-food and coffee chains, featuring cuisines from around the world. Laurel Street has been transformed into a pedestrian zone dedicated to alfresco dining, which has spurred its diversity in eateries. On Sunday mornings during the summer, Laurel street is also home to a weekly farmer's market.


Boutique shops and services in downtown San Carlos not only provide for the residents' essential needs but also a means to support local businesses. Some shops and buildings even date back to the early 1900s, serving as monuments of San Carlos's rich culture and history. Places like the Reading Bug Bookstore, Diddam's Toystore, The Clocktower Music, Bow-Wow Meow, Sarrtori Apparel, Footwear Inc., are all locally-owned shops and hold a lot of good memories from the people in San Carlos.

San Carlos is home to the San Carlos History Museum, dedicated to the display of the history of the town from early Native American history, which dates back to prior to 1769 on record. The Hiller Aviation Museum, a museum specializing in helicopter and aviation history, is another offering interactive exhibits and more than forty aircraft including a replica of the first aircraft to fly, a spy drone with a 200-foot wingspan, and the nose section of a Boeing 747.

Every May, the town hosts the "Hometown Days" carnival in Burton Park, the city's largest park. In October, the Chamber of Commerce hosts the San Carlos "Art & Wine Faire", with the event now in it's 35th year of being held.

Within San Carlos today is a population of 31,407 people residing in 11,845 households, with an average household size of 2.65 persons. Of those households, the average household income was reported at \$328,290. The top employers within San Carlos include Natera, Check Point Software Technologies, Delta Star and ChemoCentryx, Inc.

San Carlos is served by four elementary schools, two upper elementary schools and three middle schools, with the schools in San Carlos among the highest-ranking in the state; 38.7% of its residents hold a graduate or professional degree.
