Currently, 69.9% of the 63,921 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 26.6%, renter occupied; and 3.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 62,402 housing units in the area and 3.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.07%. Median home value in the area is \$262,994, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.30% annually to \$280,508.
